At the battle of New Lowell on the night of May
 my officers and men behaved with great courage,
 but it is not necessary to particularize them by
 name as they fought under my own eye.

The total loss of my Regt is as follows.

 as a brave and faithful officer he is a great loss
 to my Regt.

 gallantly leading their companies.

Jacksons advanced forces engaged Early near Richmond on Sutterington Hill at five o'clock P.M. yesterday & after four hours fighting drove them back in confusion on McDowell.
