I respectfully submit the following report of the part taken by this Regt in the Battle of the 27 of Nov 63. My position was on the extreme left of the Brigade and prior to its forward movement in line of battle, three of my largest Companies were deployed as skirmishers to the front, in compliance of Major Anderson, that left six small Companies in position on the left of the Brigade as our line of battle advanced. The skirmishers moved gradually by their right flank & the tendency of the Brigade corresponded with the direction of that line, until the position we desired to occupy on the field of battle was ascertained; it was then ordered to change direction to the left which threw the line of skirmishers after gaining our position on the battle field, on the right flank of the Brigade, where they remained until the termination of the battle. Major Anderson who was in command reported with several prisoners & among them was a field officer with his horse & equipments. The Brigade by coming up

the others. At that moment Genl Jones
seeing (I presume) some disadvantage
in the ranks of the La Brigade, ordered
me to move by the left flank a little, so as
to form in rear & in support of that Brig.
This was promptly obeyed & the timely sup-
port caused them to return to their position
& in connection with this Regt a most terrific
fire was opened upon the enemy which con-
tinued until the evening had moved so far to
their left, as to render ineffectual our fire
in consequence of an intervening hill & the
approach of night. The officers were all agree-
able. Lt Col Buckner was with me in
Command. A list of Casualties appears
with inclosed.

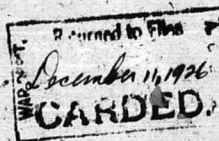

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In compliance with instructions received on the 28th inst, I have the honor to report the following as the operations of my Brigade in the affair at Mine Run, and to enclose the Report of the Regimental Commanders, except that of Lieut Col Lewis 43rd U. S. Troops, (which Regiment temporarily absent from the Brigade) which will be furnished as soon as received.

My Brigade consisting of the 32nd I. C. T. Col Brattle, the 13th U. S. T. Lieut Col Lewis, 53rd U. S. T. Co. (Twins), 45th U. S. T. Maj Smith, and the 2nd U. S. Battalion Capt Ed Smith, moved toward the Division about one o'clock on the morning of the 27th of Nov. 1863 from its breast works at Northern Ford to the "Y" Church, and then to Rockfort in the road. The night ending at the Church. About 8 o'clock A. M. the same day, the Division moved toward Roanoke Grove, this Brigade being in advance. On reaching the hill near Roanoke Grove, my skirmishers came in contact with the enemy, who appeared in very strong force upon the Gumana Road. I was ordered by the Maj. Genl. C. M. to form my line across the Road, before this order was executed, I received further orders from the same source, to hold the enemy in check with my line of skirmishers, and occupy with my Brigade a position about 1000 yards in rear upon a wooded hill and hold it until the remainder of the Division came up and could be placed in position. During the execution of this order, the enemy (greatly outnumbering our troops) pressed my line of skirmishers, but were gallantly held in check by them under the command of Capt Dodge, until the main body of the Division came up and threw out skirmishers on his right.

and left, during his short absence beyond the crest of the hill. He occupied this position until about 2 o'clock A.M. of the next day - the enemy occasionally firing our position, but making no direct attack. From here I moved with the Division to "Mines Run" and occupied the west bank of that stream, my right resting on the Dumpfike. This position we fortified strongly and held until the morning of the 2nd of December. During this time my skirmishes were frequently engaged with those of the enemy. Captains Parker & Jones commanding them behaved with great coolness as did the officers and men under their command. Lieut Pitt my acting Aid de Camp was here conspicuous for his good conduct. On the morning of the 2nd Dec I moved again to the Dumpfike and crossed the Dumpfike and occupied the position previously held by Anderson's Division, my right resting at a small stream near a "Guano", as soon as it was light I discovered that the enemy had retired from my front, and pushed my skirmishes well forward to find his whereabouts. A short time after sunrise I received orders to move to the Dumpfike and follow the Division in pursuit of the enemy on the Romana Road; after marching some five or six miles on this road I was ordered to counter-march and bivouach for the night near Locust Grove. The next morning I returned with the Division to Martins Ford.

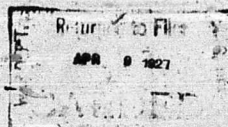
