GENEALOGY OF EDWARD BOYKIN OF VIRGINIA

Edward Boykin of Virginia was born in Caernarvonshire, Wales; came to America and settled in Virginia. He received a grant of land in the Isle of Wight County, Virginia, now in Southampton County, in 1685. In 1713, 1715 and 1724 he received other large grants. (From Land Grant Office, Richmond, Virginia) He married Ann Marshall; she died after 1728 in Isle of Wight County, Va. He made his will, Isle of Wight Co., Va., January 4, 1726, and it was probated May 27, 1728, his wife, Ann, and his son, John Boykin, as Executors. The inventory of his Estate was filed May 5, 1728. He died April 1728. The Estate was finally reported September 28, 1730 and closed February 22, 1731 by his son Edward, Jr., as Executor, as his wife Ann and son John, former Executors, had died. (In various deeds Edward Boykin refers to his wife Ann Boykin.)

John Boykin (Edward) born in Va., died Isle of Wight Co., Va., 1729. Married Ann.

He died intestate and an inventory of his Estate was filed May 5, 1729. Land deeds and transfers of land by his wife and himself are on record in Isle of Wight County Court House, Isle of Wight County, Virginia.

FRANCIS BOYKIN: (John, Edward) was born in Isle of Wight Co.,

1761. His will is on record there dated August 1, 1761, and
was probated September 1761.

He married (1) Millicent _____, and she died. Married
(2) Sarah _____. A record on file Northampton Co., N. C.
where Francis Boykin and his wife Millicent Boykin deeded to
their son, John Boykin, in 1748, 290 acres and their son, William
Boykin, was witness to the deed.

He owned a tract of land on the south side of Cypress Swamp,
Northampton Co., N. C., various other land deeds signed by
Francis Boykin and together with his wife Millicent, and also
with his wife Sarah, are on file in the Historical Commission
of North Carolina at Raleigh, N. C.

On August 3, 1727, he bought 240 acres of land on the Meherrin
River in Northampton Co. and moved there soon after.

William Boykin was a witness to a deed of land from his father, Francis Boykin, in 1748, Northampton Co., N. C. (This tract of 290 acres of land was original grant, 1723, to Simon Bryant.)

Francis Boykin (William, Francis, John, Edward) was born in Va., 1754; died in Baldwin Co., Georgia 1822.

Married Catherine Whitaker, daughter of James Whitaker and Catherine Wiggins).

She was born 1758, died in Baldwin Co., Ga., before 1822.

After the Revolutionary War, Francis Boykin, wife and children moved in 1785 from Camden S. C. to Baldwin Co., Ga., and settled on the plantation, which land was bounded on the southwest side by the Oconee River and the southeast side by an island, on all other sides by vacant lands. Here he established his home until his death in 1821. He and his wife are both buried in the family graveyard near his home. His grave as a Revolutionary Soldier has been marked by the Nancy Hart Chapter, DAR of Milledgeville, Georgia. He was a Revolutionary Soldier of South Carolina, served as Lieutenant of South Carolina Regiment, Continental Establishment, Captain, South Carolina Company, and Major in Colonel Charles Myddleton's Regiment, 2nd Regiment, S. C. State Dragoons. (from pages 53, 87 and 120 "South Carolinians in the Revolution" by Sarah Sullivan Erwin, published 1949.)

The family of Major Francis Boykin

In Camden, S.C. subse uent to the Revolutionary War, Major Francis Boykin served as clerk of the court. He was a distinguished Revolutionary soldier. He married Catherine Whitaker, daughter of James Whitaker. In 1785 a deed of 287 1/2 acres of land was made to Francis Boykin and Zachariah Cantey, by Philip Logan, for the consideration of 100 pounds sterling. This land which was bounded on the southwest side by the Oconee River, on the southeast side by an island, on all other sides by vacant land, had been granted to Samuel Blount in 1784. Here Major Francis Boykin, with his wife, Catherine Whitaker, established his home, where he lived until his death in 1821. The date of his wife's death is unknown. Major Francis Boykin was buried in the family graveyard near his home. His grave has in recent years marked by the Nancy Hart Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution.

Eliza Boykin, daughter of Catherine Whitaker and Francis Boykin, married William Rutherford. * * * James Boykin, the youngest son of Major Francis Boykin and his wife, Catherine Whitaker, served in the war of 1812. * * * Samuel Boykin, eldest son of Major Francis Boykin and Catherine Whitaker, was a distinguished physician and scientist. After his father's death, he inherited a portion of his father's plantation; however, he made his residence in Milledgeville, Ga., where he practiced his profession very successfully. He built and resided in a house on Jefferson Street. * * * In his home La Fayette was entertained in 1825. In an old letter written January 7, 1894, by Prof. William Rutherford to Rev. Thomas Boykin, Professor Rutherford said, "I remember distinctly in 1825 General La Fayette visited the United States and your father sent his carriage and his pair of large bob-tailed bays and another pair, making a coach and four, to Sparta, and he (the general) drove up to your father's house, where a grand reception was held. I was six or seven years old and I remember that the general took me up in his arms". Later in the letter he adds, "I am now in my 76th year." Dr. Samuel Boykin's name appears on the invitation issued to the ball in honor of La Fayette at the State House.

Dr. Boykin was one of the commissioners of Milledgeville, Ga. After accumulating quite a fortune - for those days - he gave up his practice, moved to his plantation, and built the colonial home still standing. He was a man of study and scientific research, well known among scientists of his age. Among his experiments was one proving that sugar cane can grow at this latitude in Georgia, making all the tests on his own plantation. He was a botanist of note. In 1836 Dr. Boykin moved to Columbus, Ga., where he engaged in banking. He died in Columbus in 1848. Dr. Boykin was twice married; first to Miss Maxwell, who bore him one son; then to Miss Cooper, by whom he had four sons and four daughters.

Dr. Samuel Boykin (born 1786, died April 27, 1848) married first Sarah A.M. Maxwell (born Aug. 1797, died November 1820) by whom he had one son, Burwell Boykin (b. Feb. 14, 1819, d. Nov. 18, 1857).
