

LONDON, July 28.

Admiral Keith informs the Admiralty, that H. M. vessel the Briton, captured on the 3d of this month, off Bordeaux, the American 'privateer' Joel Barlow, from Charleston bound to France.

The American privateers continue to infest the coast of the Hebrides.

By the convoy that is now assembling at Spithead, detachments will be sent for every English regiment now in North America, officers will also be sent for the Canadian militia, with a great quantity of naval and military stores.

August 7.

The convoy destined for English America, sailed on Friday last from Falmouth to the number of about 100 sail, escorted by the Albion of 74 guns, two frigates and a sloop of war.

It was reported at Gothenburgh, that an American frigate, and a large armed schooner of the same nation, were upon the coast of Norway.
