teaching a country school for a time,
 taught at Thomson and in 1868 took over
 the school in Princeton. In 1870 he
 married and brought up his family of
 six boys and five girls living to see
 all of them happily married with
 children of their own.
 He was Principal of the Princeton School
 until 1898 when he retired from all
 work. Forty years as principal of one
 school which bears his name officially
 in the Georgia School System. He died
 April 20th 1910 leaving a monument
 of fame as a teacher, character
 builder for several generations.
 After the death of Grandmother Boone
 Grandfather with his family moved to
 Mt. Lebanon, near Eadsburg in northern
 Louisiana. His sons Rev. D. Boone and
 Jim Boone were lawyers. Henry was
 an iron found and banker. I am named
 in my united family Henry. Mother's
 only sister married there, a Mr. Day
 who was a splendid gentleman &
 his sons are prominent in their
 section.

The negroes from politics and theft
 campaigns, farmers neglected, no food or
 money. The left arm being almost useless my
 friend Saml. H. Chapman decided to back
 him. Chapman then followed after
 leaving college. He secured a grant of
 land from the college under its president, John
 Wilson. Later he moved to Mason
 and its original location in Green
 County. He was renamed Mercer University.
 Before forming Danville College Mr.
 Wilson was for about fifteen years
 pastor of the Danish Church and
 principal of the school at Danville.
 He fought for nearly before the
 war as a volunteer in Kent County.
 When he married one Miller who
 was his wife. Later he taught at
 Danville and from here enlisted in
 the army of the South. Badly wounded
 he left again in the battle of
 Gettysburg 1863. He was not again
 able to take up arms. After peace
 was declared he lived on his
 farm near Crossroadsville, forming

Our lineage running backward is
Henry Chapman Jr. son of John Henry
Chapman, son of Samuel Boston Chapman,
son of John Chapman son of Nathan
Chapman, son of John Chapman.
The original John Chapman who was
a Revolutionary patriot lived in
Savannah County Ga. but returned to
North Carolina and died in 1802
in Wadesville N.C. He had three sons
Nathan, Thomas & Benjamin located in
Chatham, Benjamin later going west
to Iowa in Iowa County.
John Chapman my grandfather was an
educated gentleman and a man of
means, serving in the Georgia Legislature
and after Sept. 1800 was his inter-
state friend. His three sons were
college men and by his will were
well provided for. William was killed
in the Civil War. Sam & John S.
were both severely wounded.
After the war was over the problem
of life was such as these young
men had never dreamed could be
