HUSBAND - Benjamin Clements

The children of Benjamin and Grissell Clements were named in the Abington Parish Register, Gloucester County, Virginia, except for George whose relationship was proved by King William Co. Va Record Book 2, 1721-1722. Nov 7 1721, George Clements of St. Margaret's Parish to William Aylett, 25 acres, being the part of the tract whereon the said Clements now resides, granted by patent bearing date 23 Oct 1703 to John Baker and conveyed by said Baker to Benjamin Clements, the father of said George Clements. Susannah Clements, wife, relinquishes her dower.

CHILD 8 - Richard Clements

According to the DNA reports, Peyton Clements was the grandson of Benjamin Clements of Gloucester County, Virginia through one of his sons, viz: George (died 1730 Bertie Co., NC did not name a son Peyton); Thomas, bapt. 22 Apr 1701 (unknown whereabouts); and Richard who was the only one discovered in the 1755 Tithables of Granville Co., NC with Peyton Clements. Richard probably married one of the daughters of Thomas Peyton of Gloucester County, VA, as the ages fit.

Halifax County, Virginia Order Book, Part 1

March 21, 1755. William Wright vs. Richard Clements on an attachment. The Sheriff having returned that he had attached all of the defendant's effects in the hands of Edward Wade, sheriff to sell defendant's mare and pay the plaintiff 3 shillings. Defendant did not appear.

We know that Mary Clements was married to Edward Wade of Halifax County, Virginia. The couple named their first son, Peyton Wade and used the other Clements first names such as Thomas and Grissel. Apparently, Richard Clements left Halifax County and went to Granville County, N. C. where he was found in 1755. According to the above Order, he did not appear to have anything much in the way of possessions except a horse and must have died intestate in Granville County. The above order proves once and for all that Mary Clements was a daughter of Richard Clements and that her husband, Edward Wade, handled Clements' affairs in Halifax County.
