## Notes

### CHILD 2 - Edmund Camp

Edmund Camp was a farmer who emigrated with his father from Virginia, settling first in SC, later Franklin County, Georgia; buried beside his last wife, Elizabeth Carney Camp. He was a Pvt in the Revolutionary War, enlisting from Tryon Co., NC; Ensign in 1776. His application for pension R1614 was rejected, but his widow, Elizabeth Carney Camp drew a pension W35232.

### CHILD 5 - Thomas Camp

Thomas Camp served in the 4th SC Regt Artillery in 1776 under the command of Col. Barnard Beekman. 1791-2 he was a delegate from Horse Creek Baptist Church (now Fork Shoals) in Greenville County near the Laurens County, SC Line. South Carolina Baptists by Leah Townsend.

### CHILD 9 - Benjamin Camp

Benjamin Camp was a Revolutionary War Soldier, 2d Virginia Regt under Capt. Nathaniel Welch and fought with his brothers (Nathan and John) at Cowpens; removed to South Carolina before 1790, then to Walton County, Georgia.
