This indenture made and entered to this the nineteenth  
day of July in the year of our Lord eighteen  
hundred and fifty two, between Robert J. Cowart,  
of the County and State aforesaid of the one part,  
and Thomas B. Jackson of the same place of the  
other part.

Witnesseth that the said Robert J. Cowart for and  
in Consideration of the sum of Six Hundred  
and fifty Dollars East to him in hand paid  
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof is acknowledged. hath granted  
breviled sold and Conveyed unto the said Thomas  
B. Jackson all those tracts or parcels of Land aforesaid  
lying no less in the third District of said County,  
known and distinguished in the form of said  
District by the number Eight hundred and seventy one  
811, East hundred and twenty two (8112) Nine hundred  
and forty nine (929) nine hundred and forty  
four (944) feet. Six acres of the last named  
lot which said lots have been previously sales  
said lots running from south to south along the  
West line of said lot, containing one hundred  
and eight fourches more or less, with all the rights  
common and appurtenant thereto belonging or in any wise

plan of the Survey as lot No. 30 Nine Hundred and  
thirty in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Second section & 3<sup>d</sup> District con-

the above designated lot unto the said Nelson  
Dickerson his heirs and assigns together with all dom-  
estic & other rights & privileges appertaining to
