Neither the name Thomas Starke, nor the name Archelaus Harris, has been found on the records on file in this office of soldiers from Virginia in the Revolutionary War, nor has the name Owen Fluker been found on the records as of that war.

The collection of Revolutionary War records in this office is far from complete, and it is suggested as a possibility that the desired information may be obtained from the Librarian, Virginia State Library, Richmond, or from the Commissioner of Pensions, Washington, D. C.

It is possible that information relative to those who took part in the battle of King's Mountain may be obtained from a recent unofficial publication of Kathrine K. White, entitled, "The Story of the battle of King's mountain," which contains sketches of about one thousand who took part in that engagement.
