Elisha Holland (1764-1833) of Wayne Co., N. C. He had a son, Eli who went to GA, died at age 87. Listed 1840 Census Johnson Co.

There was a Johnson Co., N. C. marriage in 1822 and he was listed 1830 Johnson Co. Census as well as 1840-50 census index.

Meanwhile, there is an Eli Holland listed 1820 Census Index as being in Laurens Co., GA. In 1830 Fayette Co., GA there is a Rebecca Holland age 50-60, one male 15-20, male 20-30, female 5-10, 2 females 10-15, one female 15-20.

The 1840 Fayette Co., GA. Census lists Eli Holland age 20-30, one female under 5, one feamel 15-20, one female 20-30, one female 50-60. In 1850 the Eli Holland family is found in Cherokee Co., AL (Census taken 1/17/1851), Eli age 39, Eliza 28, Jane 10, Mary 8, Nancy 6, Samuel 3, Emily 1/12 b. AL, everyone else b. GA. Also, in 1850 Fayette Co. Census, Tarlton Holland family consists of: Tarlton 37, Susan 35, Lindsay 11, Eliza 9, Andrew I. 8, Rebecca 6, Washington 2, Rebecca Holland 74, VA.

In 1860 Eli Holland family is in Carroll Co., GA. Eli 48, Eliza V. 37, Mar y A. 19 (Molly Shaw died in OK), Nancy J. 15, Samuel G. 12, Emily 10, Susan D. 7 (Susan Newsome d. OK), David 4, and Eliizabeth Harriett Ann Holland 8 months -- married Hezekiah Ransom Yancey, d. OK 6/20/1907 (my grandparents). In 1870-1880 she was living with her Pyle grandparents.

In 1863 Eli Holland was on list for Militia duty for the Confederate Army, age 51 in Campbell Co. and showed he had a rifle in good condition. In later years, Eliza. had 3 sisters (Molly, Susan and Emily). No brothers?

When dying of cancer in OK a granddaughter of Elisha Holland, more than once, took care of Eliza. Holland Yancey, a great-granddaughter of Elisha, in her home in Chandler, OK, when she was too weak to ride the 7 miles back home in a wagon.

Perry, Judge of the Circuit Court of the said county of Sumter now in session, John Holland at present a resident of said county of Sumter and state aforesaid, aged sixty seven or thereabout, and who being first duly sworn according to the law doth on his oath make the following amended declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the Act of Congress passed 7th June 1832 and when he was a citizen of Marengo County, made a declaration on oath before the Hon. William J. Alston, Judge of the County Court of said county, in order to obtain the bennefit of the provisions made by the Act of Congress of the 7th June 1832, but the declaration made has been

rejected by the proper department of the general government, and since the making of which this declarant has removed from the county of Marengo to the county of Sumter aforesaid, where he now resides. This declarant has heretofore stated is between sixty seven and sixty eight years of age. He enlisted in the army of the United States in the year 1778 with Captain John Bowie then of Abbeville District of the State of South Carolina and served in the under the following named officers. He belonged to a company commanded by Captain John Bowie of which John Howard and Thomas Prince were Lieutenants and Samuel Earle, Ensign. This applicant is not distinct in his recollection as to the n ame of his Colonel of the Regiment to which he belonged, but thinks it was Col. Pickens or Col. Williams. He was under Genl. Williamson. Lieut. Prince was wounded in the service at the Battle of Stows?. Ensign Earle contined in the service until this applicant left it and when the applicant last heard from him, lived in Pendleton District in South Carolina. This applicant or declarant enlisted as well as he remembers in the year 1778 or thereabout, but as to the precise date he is not certain because he was very young at the time. he enlisted to serve for the duration of the war and was discharged as well as he remembers in the year 1780 in Abbev ille District of South Carolina. he is confident he served something upward of two years and served in the capacity of a Drummer for the Company commanded by Captain Bowie. He was so young at the time, that he was enlisted for the purpose of acting as a Drummer to the Company and was enlisted when he was very young as aforesaid. he lived in Abbeville District as aforesaid when he enlisted and served as before stated. he received no written

discharge that he now remembers, but as he was young at the time he thinkks it likely his father did for him, but of this he is not certain as his father died many years ago......Answers to the questions propounded was that since the Revolutionary War he removed to Kentucky and lived in Greene Co. and afterwards in Caldwell Co., then removed to Marengo Co. in 1818, where he lived until a few weeks ago, when he removed to Sumter Co. He knew Capt. John Moore, Capt. Benjamin Tutt, and officers...

According to all accounts he owned a general store in Dardanelle and a farm in Pottsville.

He married Sarah Quinn. According to my great Mary Umfleet (his eldest grandchild) he owned more than 100 slaves. I always found that difficult to believe since that section of Arkansas is at the foothills of the Ozarks and it was not likely that large plantations would be found that far north in Arkansas. According to all family knowledge, he and his wife died while all children were minors. The children returned to Gaston Co. to lie with relatives. Mary Umfleet stated to me that an attorney (Mr. Mason) from Gaston Co. traveled by horse and wagon. to Arkansas to settle the estate for the children only to find that the sheriff and plantation foreman held titles to all properties.

James Harvey Holland was the only male child of Jasper Holland. He m. Mary Elizabeth (Molly) Wilson from York Co., S. C. It is know that he killed his brother-in-law over some form of disagreement. To the best of my knowledge he fled to the Carolinas and went back west. According to Mary Umfleet (his daughter and my great aunt) he killed the sheriff and the plantation foreman who took title to his father's property (I have no evidence of this). He did kill some other people in the area of Arkansas, Missouri, and/or

Illinois. My grandfather would never discuss this, but Aunt Mary would. he did serve time in prison in Missouri. I think he died in Illinois. Of the few people I have met who knew my great grandfather, they have described him as a "man of action".

James Darby Holland and his siblings were raised by different families in York Co., S. C. after their mother had died and their father had fled the county. They were always a close family although none were raised in the same households.

Mary (the eldest) joined her father in the west and remained there the rest of her life. She married Tom Umfleet who owned a small manufacturing company in Mt. Pleasant, Texas, but they bore no children.

Newton Wallace Holland went west to live with his father, but came back to settle in Gaston and York Co. areas.

James Darby Holland, my grandfather, worked most of his younger years as a carpenter. Around 1920 he became the Chief of Police in Clover, york Co., S. C. During the depression he took a position in Gaston Co. as a construction superintendant. He and his siblings were stern people who were very well respected in their communities.

Edwin A. Holland came from Paulding Co. to Polk Co. when he was twenty-one years old, met Frances Taylor, fell in love and married her. They moved to Taylorsville in Bartow Co. and bought a home and land. They had eleven children, Joseph Seward Holland was the youngest. He was four years old when the family moved to Polk Co. Edwin and Frances lived there until their deaths, both in January of 1917.

Joseph Seward met Mollie Josephine Wilkerson at a party in 1917 and he remarked to a friend that she was the girl he was going to marry and they were married that year. They had three children.
