LETTER FROM LANY HOLLAND, in Huntsville, Alabama Library

Letter to Margaret from Lany Holland dated Feb 12, 1964:

"One of my cousins made some search for our family and I am giving you what she said about the Hollands:

Henry Langston was born 23 Jan 1769 on his fathers plantation near Langston Church. He married Sarah Murphy, who born in Ireland Nov 29, 1769. she came over with her parents when she was 7 years old. Her father was a scotch Presbyterian. HE spoke Gaelic. They were Scotch who settled with Protestants in Northern Ireland on account of their religious beliefs and then immigrated to America. Their children were Margaret, James, William, Mary, Sarah, John, Mahaleth, Thomas and Tirzah.

Mahaleth Langston married Jeremiah Holland. Their children were John, Henry, Thomas, Mary, Sarah, Jane, Charity, Eliza, Armentie and Ann. Mary married a Greenslade, Sarh md William H. Aston, Charity md a Norwood, Armentie md John Armstrong. They lied in Anderson SC.

Jeremiah Holland and his wife Mahaleth Langston Holland immigrated to Lawrence Co Alabama.

EMIGRANTS TO PENNSYLVANIA

William Holland with consent of his father Thomas Holland, indents himself apprentice to Thomas Gant of Phila. joiner, for four years and nine months from this date to be taught the trade of a joiner, his father to find him in apparel the first year, and his master the remainder of his time, to have six weeks night schooling every winter to be paid by his father. May 19, 1746.

John Frances Holland migrated to Baltimore Apr 15, 1707, German.
