Value received, with interest from maturity at the rate of eight per annum, and if collected by law, by foreclosure or suit, I agree to pay ten per cent. additional, for Attorney's fees, and to be as amply secured thereby as the principal debt, and I hereby renounce for myself and family any and all Homestead and Exemption rights I may have under the laws of the State and of the United States as against this debt. And to secure the payment of this Note, and in consideration of one dollar in hand paid me hereby, I mortgage and convey to said BANK OF SHADY DALE, its heirs and assigns, the following property, to-wit:

All that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Shady Dale Dist., Jasper Co., Ga., containing five acres more or less, known as the Boone Lot, and bounded on North by lands of Dr. J. H.
