REVOLUTIONARY RECORDS.

"Thomas Lindley was a soldier in the Revolution being listed in"-"The Georgia Roster" page 596, Luciam L. Knight, page 596, In the "Paid In" money list is the name of Thomas Lindley published as Appendix E. Ga. Soldiers of the Line under the direction of Nrs. Nm. Lawson Peel from original papers in the Office of the Secretary of State.

Thomas Lindley's name is in the First Census, South Carolina. His will is at Laurens Court House in South Carolina. In his will he names his wife and each of his twelve children. In the same Court House are the records of all of his sons and some of his daughters. Other papers (legal) also mentioned him.

Mrs. Lizzie Glever, a kinsweman of Cersicana, Texas wrote in her memoirs (1915)

"Jenathan Lindley was a Quaker but the Blairs fought in the Revolution". It was
the Abercrambies who dressed their son as a girl, during the Revolution". Some of
the Old Lindleys fought."

At Anderson South Carolina in the old Orange County Records are the records of Johanathan Lindley and Nancey Blair before they came to Monroe County, Georgia. (About 1820).
