

Dr. Simon Smith Dies in Hospital Of Long Illness

Dr. Simon H. Smith, 42, prominent Atlanta physician, died Thursday morning in a private hospital after a long illness. He lived at 1291 Emory Road, N. E.

Dr. Smith came to Atlanta 23 years ago. He was graduated from Emory University Medical School and was a member of Phi Delta Epsilon Honorary Medical Fraternity.

He was a member of Fulton County Medical Society, Hebrew Benevolent Congregation, a Mason and a Shriner. He was past president of the Association of Jewish Doctors and Dentists and a member of the Mayfair Club.

Dr. Smith had practiced medicine in Atlanta for more than 15 years.

Survivors include his wife; a daughter, Jerilyn Smith; a son, Alan Smith, all of Atlanta; six sisters, Mrs. Doris Lane, of New York City; Mrs. Max Schwartz, of Mobile, Ala.; Mrs. Hyman Pollock, of Spartanburg, S.
