John Norton second son of William and Mary Norton was born on St Helena Island Nov 22, 1777. Was married to Rebeckah Sophia ~~Witt~~ May 6, 1800 by the Rev Henry Holcomb A M. Rebeckah Sophia baptized by Marten Swift.

Elizabeth Adeline daughter of John and R Sophia was born Jan 24, 1801. Died Oct 18, 1891

Davis Dixon Stoll, <sup>Norton</sup> born Jan 26, 1802. Obit. Mar 7, 181. *Died Mar 7, 1816 in 15 years of his life.*

Mary Charlotte daughter of Charles and Catherine Ann Lendegreen was born Nov 7, 1810 in Beaufort. Was received and adopted by John and Rebeckah S Norton as their daughter Dec 28, 1814.

Catherine Ann daughter of Charles and Catherine Ann Lendegreen was born Jan 10, 1808 in Beaufort received and adopted as another gift of providence by Mohn and R S Norton Dec 24, 1817.

Written about 1820 by James Deant

My dear Brother

My dear Susan is yet alive and there are some signs of amendment in this case. The doctor thinks her better but I am afraid to indulge my hopes th disease often flatters. It is thought that the plague rages (or ravages) there are many new cases. Yesterday only THREE (some number, but cant make it out O)---- but it is feared there will be more today, than heretofore. God bless you all. Be often at the throne of Grace for us. The weather is much against us. I am, Your brother

Andrew Lendegreen of Sweden
