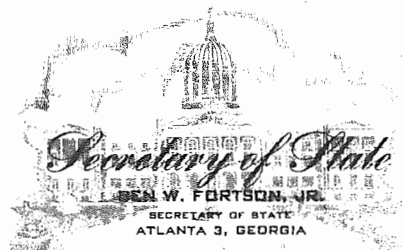

SEALS OR

being duly elected and returned, are hereby commissioned

of the Uniformed Militia, of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the 2^d Brigade of the Sixteenth Division, composed of the Uniformed Militia of the Counties of Bedford, Somerset, Cambria and Blair.

To have and to hold this Commission, exercising all the powers, and discharging all the duties thereunto lawfully belonging and attached, until the third Monday of August, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, if you shall so long behave yourself well, and perform the duties required by law.

My testimony whereof, I have set my hand, and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed to these presents, at Harrisburg, dated agreeably to law, the *eight* day of *June* in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and *seventy-five* and of the Commonwealth the *seventy-five*.
