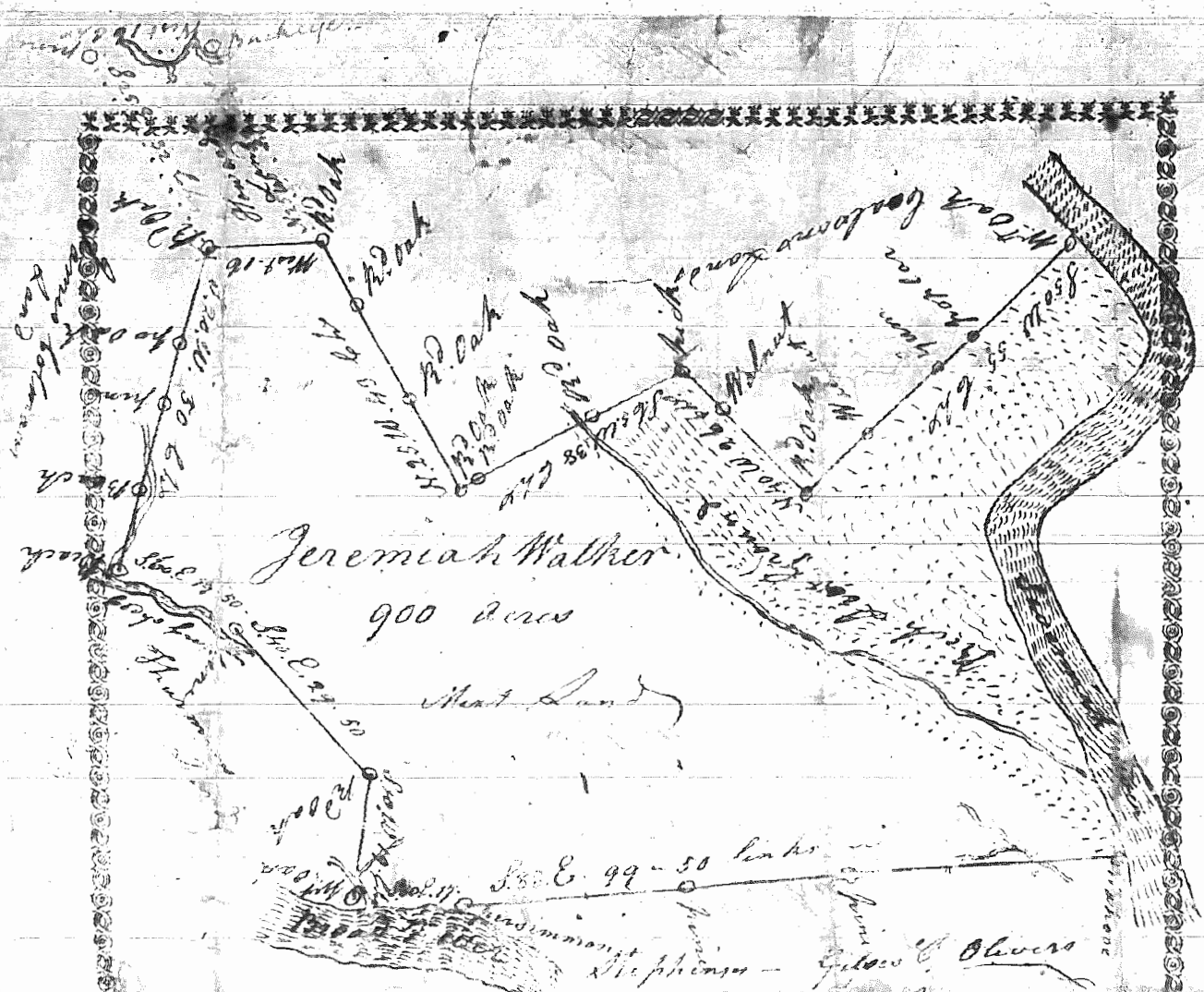

 Esquire, Senior Justice, presiding at a Land Court, held in *Wilkes County*  
 Dated the *Second* Day of *May* One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty-*five*  
 was Surveyed for *Jeremiah Walker* who actually  
 resides in this State, a Tract of Land containing *Nine Hundred*  
 Acres on *Savannah & Broad Rivers* in *Wilkes*  
 County, Buting and bounding *Northwardly by Galtson & Howard*  
*Westwardly by James Coleman's land South westwardly*  
*by Thurman's land and Southwardly by Stephens*  
*Gilves & Olivers land and on other Sides by*  
*Savannah & Broad Rivers*

having such Shape, Form, and Marks, as appear by a Plat of the same hereunto annexed; together with all and singular the Rights, Members, and Appurtenances thereof, whatsoever, to the said Tract or Parcel of Land belonging, or in anywise appertaining; and also all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest, Claim, and Demand, of the State aforesaid, of, in, to, or out of, the same; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or Parcel of Land, and all and singular the Premises aforesaid, with their and every of their Rights, Members, and Appurtenances, unto the said *William Watson* his Heirs and Assigns, to *his* and their own proper Use and Benefit forever, in Fee Simple. GIVEN under my Hand in Council, and the Great Seal of the said State, this *Twenty* Day of *October* in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty-*five* Year of American Independence.
