John Banister Collins, b. ca 1788 S. C., d. betw 1866/70 Habersham Co., Ga. m. Sarah Angle, b. ca 1787 S. C., d. 1850/60 Habersham Co., Ga. dau. of Charles Angle who made deed of gift dtd 8/20/1806 Franklin Co. Ga. to his daus, Sally and Lucy, stepson, John Banister Collins, stepdaus., Betsy and Mary Collins. John Banister Collins is purchasing land in the Franklin Co. Ga. deeds from 1814 to 1825. He was listed on 1820-50 Franklin Co. Ga. Census. He deeded land 10/20/1865 in Habersham Co. to Isham Collins, 1000 acres. Issue: Charles O., b. 1810/1815 Franklin Co. Ga. m. 9/25/1830 Franklin Co. John Collins, Sr. of Cobb Co, Ga. was Rev. War Soldier, b. 12/9/1760 Frederick Co., Md., m. Phebe Sailors 11/30/1786. His pension dtd Hall Co., Ga., in 1832, says he is age 73, lived Camden dist, York Co., S. C. at time of war, then removed to Elbert Co. Ga. 9 yrs, Franklin Co. Ga. 18 yrs, until 1813; thence removed to Hall Co. He d. 3/8/1852, aged 91 at Acworth, and his bur. at Marietta Cemetery, Acworth, Ga. His wid., Mrs. Phebe Collins, was b. 1771 S. C., her widow's pension stating she was aged 86 on 1/31/1853, living in Cobb Co., Ga., and was m. 11/30/1786 in Burke Co., Ga. They were listed on 1850 Cobb Co. Census. Issue: Felix Collins, b. 5/13/1801, d. 10/13/1873, bur. Mars Hill Cemetery, Acworth, Cobb Co., Ga.; Daniel Collins, b. 6/13/1813, d. 8/8/1890, merchant, bur. Henry Collins, b. 1798 Ga., minister, w., Lucinda, b. 1811 Ga., dau. of Elizabeth Smith, b. 1755 Pa., living with them in Cobb Co. 1850., having issue: William J., b. 1831 and Jesse M., b. 1834.

Jacob S. Collins, b. 1788 N. C., d. 1866 Cherokee Co., Ga., is the progenitor of Collins in Cherokee Co. His w., Jane, b. 1791 N. C. David H. Collins was admr of est of Jacob S. Collins, 5/7/1866 Cherokee Co. Ga. Issue as follows:

- William Collins of Oglethorpe Co., Ga., was b. 1793 Ga., farmer, d. after 1850 Oglethorpe Co., Ga. m. 9/26/1813 Oglethorpe Co., Ga., Nancy Buttery, c. 1796 Ga. Oglethorpe Co. DB R, P. 157, 4/18/1848, William Collins of Oglethorpe Co. Ga. to Beverly Thomas Collins, his son, 494 acres on Indian Creek. Issue as follows:

IV. Eliza Collins, b. 1814 Oglethorpe Co. Ga. m. David W. Patman 12/18/1828 Oglethorpe Co., Ga., b. 1810 Ga., listed 1850 Oglethorpe Census Issue: William F. Patman, b. 1832; John W. Patman, b. 1841; and Martha Patman, b. 1844, all Oglethorpe Co., Ga.

There were two who came from Jones Co., N. C. to Tattnall Co., Ga. The first was Benjamin Collins' son, Hardy. (Benjamin left LWT Jones Co. N. C. dtd 1812 naming wife, Martha and issue: Elsie, Fanny, Martha, Hardy, and Benjamin).

Hardy Collins was b. ca 1775 in Jones Co., N. C. and was listed on the 1820-30 Tattnall Co. Ga. Census. He was a Lt. in Tattnall Co. 1816-1819, and was one of the appraisers of est. of William Holland dtd 7/6/1839 in Tattnall Co. He had a dau., Rachel, b. 1806 Tattnall Co. Ga. who m. John Holland 7/7/1827 Tattnall Co.

The other was Josiah Collins who came from N. C. and had a son, John Collins, b. 1806 Tattnall Co., Ga., d. 1885, w., Mary Ann, b. 1820, alive in 1895, and had 14 children, i. e.: Joshua, b. 1840; July Ann, b. 1841; Josiah, b. 1843; Susan, b. 1844 m. E. H. Hancock, lived Richmond Co., Ga.; Mary, b. 1846; William, b. 1848; John, b. 1849; Stephen; Jimerson, b. 5/26/1854 m. 10/1886 Maggie, dau. of Jackson and Roxa Bird (issue: Mertie, Carl, Eva and Dean); Julia m. Bryant Jones of Bulloch Co. Ga.; and Eliza who m. L. L. Hodges of Tattnall Co. Ga.

Humphrey Collins of Paulding Co., Ga. was b. 9/17/1835 S. C., m. 8/20/1855 in Paulding Co., Elizabeth Bone, b. 1840 Madison Co., Ga., dau. of Bailey Bone and Nancy Georgia, died 9/17/1885 Paulding Co., Ga., and after his death his wid. married Isaac Pace 1/24/1896 Paulding Co. They were listed 1860-1880 Paulding Co. Census, and are bur. Mt. Olivet cemetery, Dallas, Ga. and Dallas City Cemetery, Dallas, Ga. Issue as follows:
