- Milson Conner, b. 7/7/1768 Marlboro Co., S. C., d. 1844 Montgomery Cc., Ga., according to his Bible, owned by Mrs. Gladys Poe, Mt. Vernon, Ga., was a son of Thomas Conner, Jr., b. 1727, d. 9/12/1802 and his w., Ann., b. 1731, d. 1791, and gr-son of Thomas Conner, Sr., c. 1678, d. 8/4/1768, aged 90 yrs, and his w., Margaret, who d. aged 50. Wilson Conner removed to Ga. after 1793, ordained to ministry in Effingham Co., Ga. in 1803, a traveling minister for years in Ga.; a Senator from Screven Co., Ga. in 1840, and d. in the pulpit in Telfair Co., Ga. in 1844.
