Jasper Co. Inv., Apprs, etc., Bk 9, P. 8-19, est. of Elijah Cornwell, 10/31/1822 distribution to heirs, P. 15-17. The Bible of George W. and Eliza D. Cornwell of Jasper Co., Ga., filed at Ga.
