

DANIELLY

John Danielly, b. ca 1740, d. 1806 Columbia Co., Ga., intestate. Granted 100 acres in St. Paul's Parish (Richmond Co.) in 1774, asked for 287 1/2 acres in Washington Co., Cert. of Col. G. Lee dtd 3/11/1784. In 1790 he recd land grant of 274 acres and 350 acres in Washington Co. Columbia Co. deed 8/5/1786, John Danielly, John Curry, John Stapler and William Shields to Thomas Stapler, 200 acres on Cane Creek, Columbia Co. Issue follows:

- II. Arthur Danielly, d. 1821 Baldwin Co., Ga., intestate. Orphans in Baldwin Co. ests listed as: James, Luesa B., Mariah B., with Sarah Danielly, admx. Baldwin Co. Ann. Returns, 1820-24, P. 228: "To Thomas Danielly, in rt. of his wife; boarding James, minor; boarding Mariah B., minor, and boarding Luesa B., a minor." Sarah Danielly listed on 1850 Bibb Co. Ga. Census, b. 1770 Delaware. Issue follows:
1. John Danielly, b. ca 1789, m. Ellen Lucky 6/13/1809 Richmond Co., Ga. "Died at Milledgeville March 31, 1818, John Danielly, a young merchant who had commanded a company in the Indian war." Ga. newspaper records. He had a son, William J., whom Eliza State 1/24/1828 Bibb Co., Ga.

- III. Francis Danielly. At Columbia Co., Ga. Auction 12/17/1810 the est. of John Lazenby sells 500 acres, orig. gtd. to Thomas Ayres, Francis Danielly and wife, etc., to highest bidder. Francis Danielly m. Elizabeth Ayres, dau. of Thomas Ayres, the latter dying 1773 Richmond Co., Ga. Columbia Co. deed 5/8/1792, Thomas Ayres and wife, Sarah, et al, Francis Danielly and wife, Elizabeth, of Wilkes Co., James Danielly and wife, Bridget, William Ayres and wife, Frances and John Ayres and wife, Mary, all of Columbia Co., to John Lazenbury, 250 acres, out of 500 acres on Great Kiokee Creek. Also deed 11/27/1790, Francis Danielly and wife, Elizabeth, "of Hancock Co.", etc. to John Darsey, 50 acres on Great Kiokee Creek. Francis Danielly probably had dau., Jane, who m. Solomon Ward, 12/15/1806, Columbia Co., Ga.
- IV. Daniell Danielly, b. ca 1768, d. after 1802, m. Elizabeth Prather, 4/10/1788 Richmond Co., Ga. 11/15/1788, in Richmond Co., Daniel was apptd one of appraisers of est. of Richard Graham. Daniel listed as an

invalid Revolutionary War Soldier in Ga. in 1795, no legal evidence being produced, however. The first deed record of him in Richmond Co. dtd 6/11/1787, John Massey to Daniel Dannelly of Augusta, Ga., Bill of Sale, for slaves, DB A2, P. 24. 5/31/1787 Henry Allison deeded him 200 acres on Big Kiokee Creek, Bk IG, P. 115. There are various deeds in Columbia Co. for him from 1793 to 1800, buying and selling lands on Kiokee Creek. The est. of Daniel Prater, decd, in Richmond Co., dtd 12/2/1788, names Elizabeth Danielly, w. of Daniel, admx, with James Danielly, sec. The LWT of Elizabeth Danielly, wife of Daniel, recorded 4/1/1822, Columbia Co., Ga., names as heirs her dau., Elizabeth Prather Danielly, Mary Prather, dau. of Edward Prather, Nancy Prather, Margaret Shaw, Nancy Carroll, and Mary McNeare and Jincey Fudge. Issue follows:

3. James Danielly, their only son, d. 9/2/1808, aged 16 years in Columbia Co., Ga., Published Augusta Chronicle dtd 9/17/1808.

V. James Danielly, b. ca 1760, d. 1802 Columbia Co., Ga. He first lived in Richmond Co, and was Sec. of Est. of Charles Simmons 3/26/1788. Wife, Bridget, prob. dau. of Thomas Ames of Richmond Co. Ga. 4/24/1783 Roger Quarles gtd to James Danielly 150 acres on Great Kiokee Creek, Richmond DB B2, P. 8, and he owned various tracts on sd creek, and Trading Road. He had transactions in Wilkes Co., an exchange of slaves in 1785, and purchasing 200 acres on Long Creek. 3/21/1795, Columbia Co., James Danielly sold to Robert Flourney for 10,000 pds., 14,000 acres on Buggy Grit Creek and Ft. Creek. The est. of James Danielly was adm. Columbia Co. 1802 by wife, Bridget Danielly and Daniel Danielly, inv. recorded 5/24/1802. James Danielly, a resident of Ga. and S. C., applied for Rev. pension from Govt., No. 2657, but was rejected. Lucian Lamar Knight, Georgia Roster of the Revolution, V. 973.3, a certificate was issued by Col. Elijah Clarke dtd 4/1/1784, stating that James Danielly was a Minute Man, though not an inhabitant of this State at time of enlistment; James Danielly asks for 250 acres in Washington Co.; with Col. William Candler certifying that he was a refugee soldier under his command.

VI. Patrick Danielly, Indian Trader. Columbia Co. deed, 9/2/1794, Patrick Danielly, formerly an Indian Trader, for love and affection, to James Danelly "my only son", a minor, born illegitimate to a white woman, all the negroes now in my possession."

The long search for the father of **John Danielly**, born ca 1740, died 1806 in Columbia County, Georgia has discovered few clues. One of them is as follows:

John Danly, born 5 December 1755, christened 22 February 1756 in Saxagotha, South Carolina, son of James and Mary Danly. Other christenings in the E. Morcier House, Saxagotha, S. C. include:
