Lunenburg Co., Va. May of 1755 or 1758, he does not recollect which. After the war, in 1782 or 1783, he removed to Surry Co., N. C., in 1799 to Greenville Co., S. C. for two years, thence to Pendleton dist., S. C. for three years until about 1820, thence to Franklin Co. Ga. Hooper Genealogy, a Southern Branch, by Flora Hooper, state he was b. 1756 and m. in Halifax Va. 1/13/1783 to Mrs. Elizabeth Adams Word, wid. of Charles Word, who was killed at the Battle of Kings Mtn; and that he d. after 1836, bur. at his old homestead in now Banks Co., Ga., tradition saying he had three marriages, the 2d one to Elizabeth Word, 3rd one to Andersia Dolba Miller.
