## PHINIZY

William Ferdinand Phinizy, Merchant, purchased from Walton Harris of Greene Co., 1/7/1793, 225 acres on Oconee River, adj. lands he already owned there, Greene Co. DB 2, P. 54-55. He lived first in Wilkes Co., Ga. His son, Jacob, m. Matilda Stewart 5/17/1813 Oglethorpe Co., Ga., and lived Clarke Co. in 1830. Another son, Marco, lived at Athens, m. 9/6/1813 Oglethorpe Co. Ga., Nancy Baldwin. His est. admd. Clarke Co., Bk B, Admrs, Bonds, Est. of Marco Phinizy, 10/7/1816, Jacob Phinizy and John Phinizy, admrs. Jacob was made gdn of John F. and Benjamin, orphans of Marco. Issue of Jacob Phinizy follows:
