State of Georgia }
Troup County } This indenture made April 7, 1893 between Mrs. S. W. Lovelace, an heir of James Lovelace late of said County, deceased, party of the first part and L. T. C. Lovelace and J. S. Baker and H. W. Miller and J. H. Lovelace and all other descendants of the said James Lovelace, deceased, parties of the second part, Witnesseth that whereas, the said James Lovelace deceased, during his lifetime set apart one acre of land and dedicated the same to the uses and purposes of a graveyard or burying ground, and whereas the same James Lovelace died without making a deed to said acre of land and providing for its perpetuation as a graveyard as he purposed doing; and whereas in the division of his estate, among his heirs, the land on which said graveyard is situated fell to the share of his aforesaid heir, said Mrs. S. W. Lovelace, party of the first part. Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to her in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as well as for the purpose of perpetuating and preserving the said graveyard from desecration the said Mrs. S. W. Lovelace has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said parties of the second part, all other descendants of the said James Lovelace deceased the afore mentioned acre of land to wit: Measuring E, W, N&S from the center of the enclosure now on said graveyard so as to lay off one square acre of land the center of the acre so laid off to be the center of said enclosure it being parts of lots of land, Nos. 139 and 173 in the 5th land district of Troup County, said State. To have and to hold unto the said parties of the second part and all other descendants of the said James Lovelace, deceased, to be used as a family graveyard or burying ground for no other use or purpose, in perpetuity. In witness whereof the said Mrs. S. W. Lovelace has hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and year first above written.

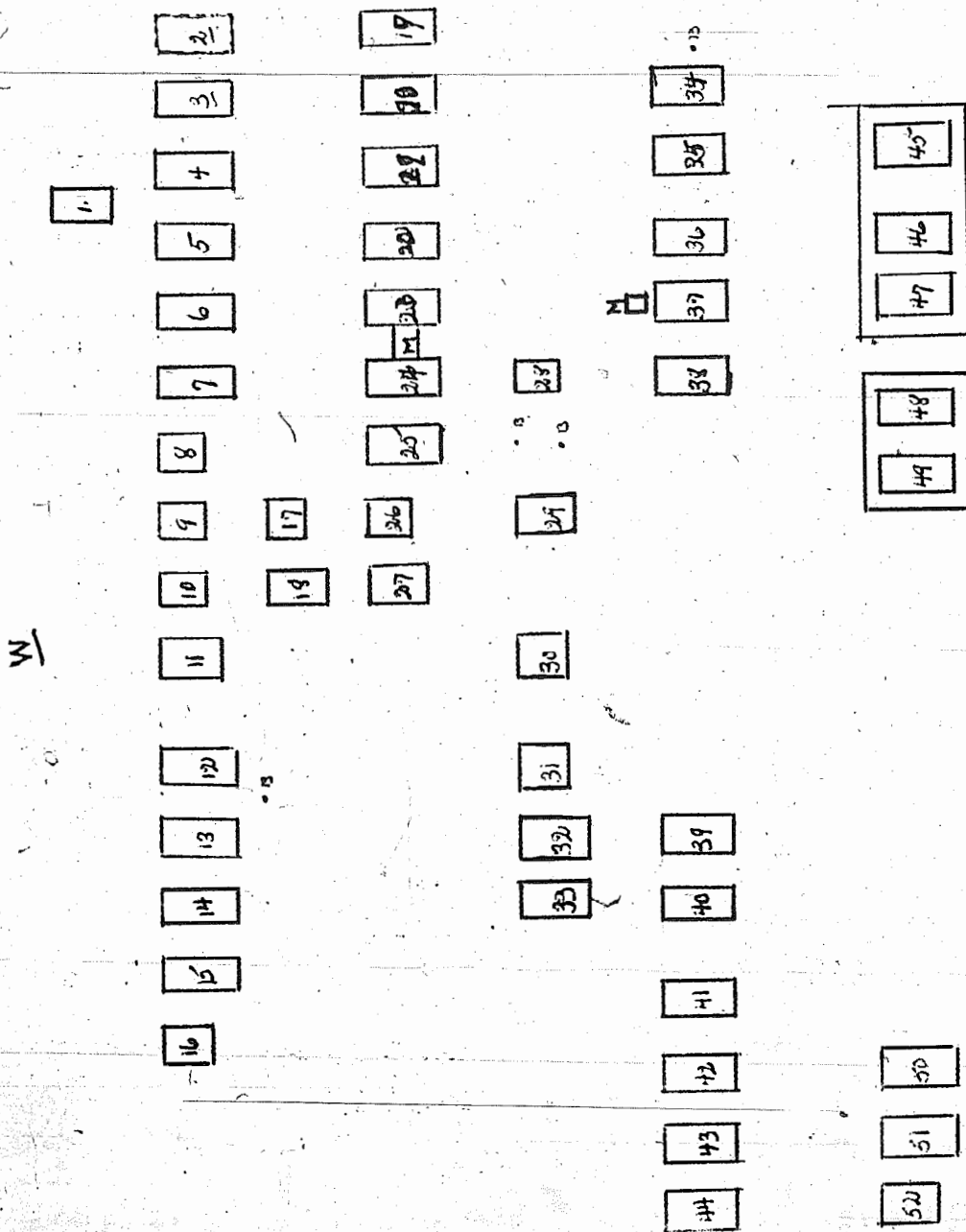
Mrs. S. W. Lovelace was Sarah Whitfield Reese, the wife of Col. John Henry Lovelace (4-13) page 45.

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→ NOTE: The LL nos. on this deed are wrong, First, because there is no LL no. 173 in the 5th land district of Troup Co. and LL no. 139 is in the northern part of the district. Second, the land set apart for Mary Lovelace's dower was LL 239 & 273. Third, the land James Lovelace owned was lots 238, 239, & 273. The error is also in the original deed, owned by the Henry Miller estate. It has taken over 100 years to discover this error, possibly because it has never gone out of the family. JLH LLs 239 and 273 are adjacent.
