The Cemetery is always well kept. It is surrounded by a well built
brick wall with attractive ~~with attractive~~ iron gates. It is located on
U. S. Highway 29, (West side) about 6 miles from West Point, Ga.

The George Hamilton Traylor House is across the highway from the
Cemetery, built about 1834. Mr. and Mrs. C. F. Maddox bought the house
and about 39 acres early in 1964 and have done considerable work and
restoration on the house. This is the first time this property has left
the Traylor family. I am the great niece of Elizabeth Lovelace
