The Cemetery is always well kept. It is surrounded by a well built built wall with attractive minkankkmakkmakimm iron gates. It is located on Noath U.S. Highway 29, (West side) about 6 miles from West Point, Ga. The George Hamilton Traylor House is across the highway from the Cemetery, built about 1834. Mr. and Mrs. C. F. Maddox bought the house and about 39 acres early in 1964 and have done considerable work and restoration on the house. This is the first time this property has left the Traylor family.
