Son of 7. Coleman A. and 7. Mary Allen; Family and Bible records.

Received 115 acres 6th District Section 5 Butts/Jasper Counties Georgia in Land Lottery of 1827. Was in Jasper Co GA bf. 1824; in Fayette Co GA by 1830 (census page 189); in Heard Co GA by 1840 (census page 305) in Henry Co GA by 1850 (census p p 305); the area of Henry that became Clayton Co GA 1859; Clayton Co GA census 1860 page 27 (248) (95). Sold land in Fayette Co in 1832 Fayette Co Deed Records Book C, Drawer 95 Box 45, page 335 to: Jesse Ward; Book P reference G 113 shows purchase of land by Y. S. Allen (references at Georgia Archives).

1870 Mortality Census of Clayton County Georgia

Reference: shown as daughter of 7. Joseph Anthony III; Will of Joseph Anthony, Fayette County GA 2/12/1846; Certified Statement furnished with DAR#339402; Anthony Roots and Branches, noted above.

Elizabeth Anthony Allen, according to her daughter-in-law, Martha McLeroy Travis Allen (wife of Benjamin Z. Allen) was a very large woman weighing well over 200 lbs. and very strong willed. She was however, exceptionally kind and loving to her children. Young Simeon Allen was very strict and several of the male children left home at a young age. Benjamin Z. left home when about 18 and went to Savannah to work; joining the Confederate Army there in 1862.

The 1860 Clayton County GA census noted above lists Young Allen age 61 and wife B. C. Allen age 54 and children at home at the time; real estate valued \$2400 and personal property \$3400.

Slaves were considered personal property and it is believed that he owned two or three.

Coleman Allen, Captain in Confederate Army. Last heard from was in AR. A dau Cecile Beatrice Allen m. J.H. Yates and moved to TX then to OK...her dau married F.A. Sewell, Pres. of a bank Oklahoma City...living there 1967. 1 son and 3 other daughters.

Drury Hambelton Allen. This family moved to AR then TX. He died at Clarksville TX. Issue: Young Simeon, Georgia, Martha (one of her daughters m. Sidney Ponder) (two of the daughters moved back to the old home place at Nashville AR). Children of Young Simeon Allen - Emily m. ---Crowley and died in Kerns TX, Drury died at Wortham TX and one of his daughters Ruby m. ---Calme and living 1975 at Wortham TX, Elsa died young.

Mary Allington Weaver 1 son Alonza Weaver

Sarah Millard Allen Renfroe. She died at Jonesboro GA. One son John Young Renfroe lived at Trinity and Galveston TX and visited Jesse Moon Allen at Palmer and Rice TX.

James Alexander Allen served in Confederate Army, captured at the Battle of Jonesboro and sent to Camp Douglas IL rel. 6/17/1865

John Young Allen Served in Civil War, 30th Georgia Company E, under Capt. W. H. Walker; killed in Battle of Jonesboro

Jesse Moon Allen. First moved to AL, then AR, then TX; issue: Amanda Elizabeth m. W.W. Stringer, Tilmon Young m. Lovie Tolleson, Jesse Alonza died in infancy, Sara Etta m. A.W. Christian, Arthur Oscar (1)m. Ollie Collins (2)m. Elda Lawrence (3)m. Annie M. Rambo, Ella Viola (who supplied much of this information) m. M.S. Miles, Maggie Buella died in infancy, Nora Lee m. T.A. Cullum, Charles A.m. Martha Mitchell, Willie Everett died in infancy.
