FAMILY NOTES

HUSBAND NOTES: John CARMICHAEL Jr

Census¹: In the 1820 census John Jr's household included two males under age six (probably John III and Nicholas); and six girls, three under age ten (probably Mary, Polly, and Elizabeth), two age six to 15 (probably Sally and Jane), and one age 16 to 25 (probably Agnes), as well as his wife Margery P.

Misc²: John Carmichael (Jr), executor of the estate of his father John Carmichael (Sr), sold 140 acres previously granted to to his father to Samuel Melquin(?) for \$140.

Misc³: John Carmichael Jr and his son John Carmichael III were appointed executors of the estate of Nicholas Styles, probably his ~~uncle~~ ^{BROTHER IN-LAW}.

Death: John was dead by 1832 when his widow Margery P. and his orphans drew in the Land Lottery of GA.

Misc⁴: Jones Co., GA, Court records related to John's estate administration following his death name his wife and children and state that John's widow Margery P. was appointed guardian for their six youngest children.

General⁵: The referenced book gives information about this family. John Carmichael Jr. had died by 1833 when his widow Margery P. was appointed guardian of their minor children Mary, John, Nicholas, Cynthia, Margery Ann, and Joseph. All but Mary are listed on the Jones Co., GA, Poor School Roster of 1833.

WIFE NOTES: Margery P.

Birth⁶:

Power/Attorney: Margery P. appointed Joseph G. Stiles as her attorney in fact to assist her in her duties as guardian of her children (Mary, John, Nicholas, Cynthia, Margery Ann, and Joseph) following the death of her husband John Carmichael. Joseph Stiles was presumably the ~~son~~ ^{brother} of Nicholas Styles (Stiles) whose estate was administered in 1832 by Margery's husband John and their son John Jr. Sarah and Elizabeth Carmichael likewise appointed Joseph Stiles as their attorney in fact as legatees to John's estate on 9 May 1833; Sarah was probably John's sister who married Nicholas Stiles.

Power/Attorney⁷: Margery P. Carmichael sold 150 acres adjoining Baty and Miller on N. Oconee River as guardian for son John Carmichael, deceased.

Census⁸: Margery P. owned 300 acres of land in the 1850 census of Jones Co. GA.
