William Cheek died in 1845 Franklin Co., Ga. He entered service of U.S. 1777 in Militia of South Carolina, Laurens Dist. under Capt. William Berry, marched to Ramburns Creek on Indian Frontier to guard against the Indians; discharged and volunteered after three months, under same office, and served again on same Indian Border for another three months. Col. John Hunter commanded both tours - discharged by Captain William Berry. In 1779 he again volunteered at Laurens, S.C. under Capt. Lewis Duvall and Col. Benjamin Kilgore and served another three months tour on said Indian Border, discharged and remained at home three months. Served every alternate three months, on that order for four years, was in the battle and stationed at number of other places than Block House Station. He resided in Laurens Dist. until 1804, going from there to Pendleton Dist, S.C.; from there to Franklin Co., Ga in 1818. He was placed on Pension Roll for service as a private Va Troops 1833. Placed on Pension Roll in 1832 for service as Priv. of S.C. Regt. under Capt. John Hunter. He was a resident of Capt Watson's Dist in Jackson Co., Ga.

Birth - September 29, 1752 in N.C. (specific place not stated)

Family- The veteran married Miss Sintha or Sinthia Coker, on September 13, 1821 in Elbert Co., Ga. The date and place of her birth and the names of her parents are not given. The veteran's widow was living in Franklin Co., Ga in 1853. She died November 17, 1860 in Jackson Co., Ga. having lived there for about 5 years before her death. The only surviving child of Sintha or Sinthia Cheek was a son L.M. Cheek who was residing in Jackson Co., Ga in 1875 and was 52 years of age at that time. She was survived by following grandchildren (their father Charles W. Cheek having died prior to 1860) M.J. Cheek, "Lyin" Cheek, Samantha Cheek, and Columbus Cheek. There are no further family data.

Residence - At time of his enlistment the veteran was a resident of Laurens Dist, S.C. He lived there until 1804, then moved to Pendleton-Dist S.C. and resided there until 1818 when he moved to Franklin Co., Ga where he continued to live until his death.

Death - April 15 (or 16) 1845 in Franklin Co., Ga.

Service - When the veteran applied for pension he stated that he enlisted in 1777 and served at various times, amounting to 2 yrs as a private with S.C. troops under Captains William Berry, Lewis Duvall and Lewis and Colonels John Hunter and Benjamin Kilgore.

Pension - William Cheek was pensioned on Certificate 16328, which was issued under the Act of June 7, 1832. The pension was paid at Georgia Agency. Sintha or Sinthia Cheek, widow of the veteran, was pensioned on certificate 2722, which was issued under Act of February 3, 1853. The pension was paid at the Georgia Agency.

Bounty Land - Warrant 29742 for 160 acres of bounty land was issued under the act of March 3, 1855, to Cintha or Sinthia Cheek, widow of William Cheek on account of his Revolutionary War Services
