Revolutionary War Pensions

Pension #27,812 of John Collins, Sr.,
application dated 1/27/1832 Hall Co., GA
He was b. 12/9/1760 in Frederick Co.,
Maryland, d. Cobb Co., near Acworth
3/8/1852, aged 91. When called into service
he was residing Camden District, now York
District, S. C., where he resided for 18 years.
In 1820 he removed to Hall Co., Ga., then
Franklin Co., GA. 5/10-10/1776, Pvt. Capt.
Robert McAfees Co., S. C. Regt., 3/1779,
Pvt. Capt. Thomas Barron's Co., SC
Horsemen, 9/1779, in Col. Archibald Lytle's
Regt. Of N. C.; captured 5/12/1780, paroled
to Lincoln Co., N. C. Where he was again

captured and sentenced, but escaped. After
this he was out scouting with refugees, was
engaged in the battle of Kings Mountain. He
enlisted in Henry Co., VA on 4/12/1781 and
served until 10/24/1781 as adjutant, as Lt. In
1782 he was Captain of a S. C. Co. His
widow, Mrs. Phoebe Collins, made her
application (#W6735) on 1/31/1853, stating
that she married 11/30/1786 in Burke Co.,
Ga., her maiden name being Sailors.

County Histories

The History of Cherokee Co. (GA)

Page 236: "David Andrew Collins
Salacoa. Born 1882 in Cherokee Co., son of
Archibald Grice Collins and Nancy
Thompson Collins. Grandson of Thomas
Robert Collins. Great-grandson of Jacob
Collins.

Married, in 1906, Mary Agnes Hutcherson,
b. 1888, daughter of Nat Hutcherson and
Margaret Hightower Hutcherson, both of
pioneer Cherokee Co. Families. Mrs. Collins'
grandfather, Thomas Hutcherson, came from
Virginia in the '40's to settle on land he had
acquired in the Salacoa district, about the
same time other Virginians were coming
there; and he and his sons, Griff, Nat, and
Thomas, Jr., became influential in the
development of 'Little Virginia' colony and
the county generally. Col. Thomas
Hutcherson Jr., who represented the county
in legislature and served as solicitor-general
of the Blue Ridge District, was considered
one of the ablest legal minds the county ever
produced.

Mr. Collins is a substantial farmer of the
Salacoa section and has taught school for 18
years in Bartow and Cherokee Counties. He

is a Baptist; Mrs. Collins belongs to Fairview Methodist Church. Both attended Reinhardt College. Their children, Thomas, b. 1907, and Susie D., b. 1914, have also attended Reinhardt."

Page 237: John Welborn Collins.

"Canton. Born Nov. 3, 1878, in Cherokee Co. Son of Archibald Grice (Bud) Collins (b. May 3, 1841 in North Carolina) and Nancy Thompson Collins (b. Sept. 12, 1851, in Pickens Co., Ga.). Grandson of Thomas Robert Collins (b. May 3, 1812 in North Carolina) and Louis Thompson (leading farmer of Pickens Co.; died at age of 92.)

Archibald G. (Bud) Collins came to Cherokee Co. From North Carolina with his father in 1848, settling in Salacoa District; became a substantial farmer and leading citizen: was justice of the peace for about 40 years; served on county juries for some 50 years. During the Civil War he served gallantly in the 43d Georgia Regiment as a non-commissioned officer.

John W. Collins attended the public schools and Reinhardt College, where he graduated in 1902 and where he was the first to attain the rank of major in the military department. Served in the U. S. Navy, Mar. 27, 1905, to Mar. 27, 1909, obtaining the rank of chief petty officer aboard the U. S. S. Louisiana, one of sixteen battleships completing a world tour in 1908-1909. Graduated from the law school of Mercer University, Macon, in June 1910. Practiced law in Canton and was city attorney and recorder for several years. From 1913 to 1917, served as assistant postmaster in the U. S. Senate. During the World War was a member of the legal advisory board of Cherokee Co. Elected in 1918 to serve an unexpired term as representative to the

legislature; relected next three terms, 1921 to 1922.

Married, Aug. 9, 1922, Ora L. Willingham, youngest daughter of Dr. W. M. Willingham, prominent physician and former mayor of Canton. They have one son, John W. Jr., b. Apr. 19, 1925. Mrs. Collins attended high school at Canton and holds the A. B. Degree from Columbia College, Lake City, Fla. She is a member of the First Baptist Church, Canton, the Canton Women's Club, and other religious, social, and civil organizations."

Susannah Collins, wife of Joseph, d. 1757. Gholson Family by Mrs. Margaret Scruggs Carruth, Dallas, TX (1950) states that Susannah was a close relative of Zachary Lewis family and cites certain deeds witnessed by Zachary Lewis I and Zachary Lewis II and Waller Lewis who was a son of

Zachary Lewis II, b. 1/1/1702 m. Mary Waller in 1725. Zachary Lewis I came to Virginia in 1692, had two sons, John and Zachary Lewis. Also had daughters. Susannah Collins would have been about the right age to be a daughter of Zachary Lewis I.

1/6/1768 Susannah Collins signed over her interest in her personal estate to her children, having already signed over her real estate to her children prior to 11/13/1760, at which time William, Thomas and Lewis sold to their brother, John, all the interest which they expected to have in the real estate of their father, Joseph Collins, upon the death of their mother, Susannah. This deed was witnessed by Lewis Sr. and Jr. and Waller Lewis, et al.
