
Greetings from British Columbia, Western Canada.

Questions that occur to me.

1. Joseph Henderson and Mahala H McMurry ..my great great grand parents,were married in Newton Cty GA 22nd September, 1825.

Question.Would Newton Cty have been the brides county and are there any wills or similar documents from her parents ?

2. Joseph and Mahala Henderson sold property in Henry Cty GA in 1826/27.

Question.Is there a record of the acquisition of these properties, by purchase,inheritance,grant,etc ?

3. I have been told that Hendersons from Henry Cty drew land in Troup Cty GA (in 1827 ?) and that a Joseph was amongst them. Question.Could it be that Joseph & Mahala sold the Henry Cty land to move to Troup ?

4. Again,I have been told that a Hannah Henderson,a widow, also drew land in Troup Cty. Now,Joseph & Mahala had a daughter also named Hannah,born circa 1836. Qusstion.Is there a connection here?

5. The census of 1850,Whitfield Cty GA shows Mahala as Mrs Harris H Wade with daughter Eliza 5 years,plus the Henderson children ( my great grand father was John D) This points to Joseph having died in about 1842/1845 in possibly Troup or Whitfield Counties. Question. Would there be a record of his death and the subsequent remarriage of Mahala in either Troup or Whitfield?

The family line from John D on has not been difficult for me to trace,and I do have an elderly Uncle & Aunt and also a cousin still settled in Dalton,Whitfield County and several members of the family are buried there including my grand parents. However the further I probe back the more difficult it becomes aspecially trying to research ' from a distance '

SUGGESTIONS: This concludes 9 hours' research into the above records. At this point it appears that I need to try and locate an estate record of Isaac P. Henderson in Newton Co. I didn't quite have time to finish searching the estate records. Also, Newton Co. was taken from Walton Co., and it appears that some of their land came from the 1st District in Walton Co., so all of those records (deeds, estates, etc.) need to be researched. Also, since your Joseph was "from Jasper Co." in 1838, that county should be searched.
