David Holliman, Sen., a native of North Carolina, migrated to Georgia about 1765, and settled in Wilkes County. Dated his will 30 October 1779, and died about 1783; will probated 1 July 1783; wife's name not known; mentions children, David, Jr., Mark residence in Warren County, Georgia, Samuel and Aley.

Samuel Holliman born in North Carolina, came to Georgia with his parents. He was a soldier of the Revolution (Roster of Georgia pp 211-231). He married prior to 1785 and the wife died 1830-5, (Sarah Rees) and he married 2d 24 February 1836, Salome McArthur, born in Georgia, 1788, residence Columbia County, Georgia. Dated his will 7 September 1850, and it was probated 4 November 1850 executors sons David and Abijah. Witnesses Nicholas Bacon, John F. Johnson, and Anderson Ivy. Children (1st wife):

- 1. Sarah born 8-11-1785; died 6-22-1866, in Georgia; married Evan Davis born 10-1-1779; died 1-14-1862.
- 2. James born 178?; married prior to 1817 Sarah believed to be the daughter of Hugh Rees, b. in Georgia, 1785 (Will of Hugh Rees, Warren County, Georgia, 1826). They had one son and two daughters in 1820. He died 1823, estate administered by David Holliman; Sarah was living in 1850; the son was Freeman W. Holliman, born 1817, married 25 march 1838, Loduska O. Wade, Columbia County No children.
- 3. Elisha born 178?; married Rennis Bull; they had three children in 1820; he died 1826, estate administered by Rennis Holliman 3-6-1826. She married Hugh Armstrong.
- 4. Abijah born 1795; married 3-24-1836 Mrs. Mary Ann Carr. Residence Columbia County in 1850. They had Albert born 1839.
- 5. David born 1797; married about 1834 and she died 1844-50; residence Columbia County. They had John, Henry, Charles, and Jane born 1844, in order named.
  - 6. Lewis H. born 1799, living in 1850. Not known if he married.
- 7. Samuel Benson born 1806/7; married 3-22-1827 Martha Harden. Residence Columbia County. They had Augustus, John, Nancy, James, Joel, and Zilly Annborn 1841, in order named.
