

## LEE

William Lee, Sr., was b. 1790 in N. C. He m. 1st, ca 1817, his wife having been born in N. C., but her name is unknown. He m. 2d, 1-7-1844 Bulloch Co., Ga., Miss Sarah Lowther, who was b. 1797 in GA., d. 1870 Bulloch Co., Ga.

The LWT of William Lee, Sr. is dated 7-7-1870, probated Dec. Term of 1870 in Bulloch Co. In it, he names his sister, Sarah Lee; son, James M. Lee; and grandchildren - James Frank Lee, Newton R. Lee, Ann E. T. Lee, the children of his son, John Lee.

The LWT of Sarah Lee (2nd wife) was dated 5-7-1873 and was probated 10-4-1880 in Bulloch Co., Ga., and it is she names her cousin, Martha Foy of Effington Co., Ga.; her nephew, Newton R. Lee; her niece, Ann E. Rogers. Named as trustees were: James M. Lee and Winfield S. Lee.

Bulloch Co., Ga. Deed Book AAAA, page 425. William Lee of Bulloch Co. Deeds to Elizabeth Lowther 2-24-1821, Bulloch Co., for \$57.00, 73 acres of land located on the east side of Spring Creek, on the waters of Belchers Mill, which adjoins lands belonging to the heirs of John Lowther.

The above deed compares in description to a deed of Stephen Bowen, Planter, of Montgomery Co., Ga. To John Everett dated 11-7-1800, for 117 acres located near Mill Creek, near a place formerly called Belchers, old cowpens, now a plantation of the aforesaid John Everett called "Spring Grove". Montgomery Co., Ga. Deed Book A, page 66.

William Lee, Sr. had a brother, James Lee, Sr. whose LWT is dated 7-13-1840, probated Sept. Term 1840, Bulloch Co., which mentioned his nephew, William Lee.

Also, Sarah Lee's LWT dated 5-7-1873, probated 10-1880, Bulloch Co. Named her brother, William Lee. (Sarah was b. 1806 in S. C.)

II. William Lee, Jr., b. 1820 Bulloch Co., Ga. m. 1st Sarah McCall 4-5-1841 Bulloch Co., and, 2nd, 10-11-1864 Mrs. Ann E. Perry, Bulloch Co., Ga. On the 1880 Bulloch Co. Census William, Jr. stated that his parents were born in N. C. The LWT of William Lee, Jr. dated 12-5-1892, probated 10-11-1892 Bulloch Co., Ga. Named his daughters: Margaret R. Gesandea, Carolina Eliza Sutton, Sarah Martha Parrish; and sons: Frank P. Lee, James B. Lee and Andrew J. Lee.

There is a Bulloch Co. Deed, in Book FM, page 177, of Samuel E. Groover to Ann E. Lee. This deed refers to Anna E. Groover, daughter of Samuel Groover, who married Elbert Lee, son of William Lee, Jr. and Sarah McCall.

Mrs. Ann E. Perry, 2nd wife of William Lee, Jr. was b. 1836 in GA. Listed 1850-1880 Bulloch Co., Ga. Census.

GENERAL LEE, SR., b. 1784 in N. C., listed on 1820-1850 Bulloch Co., Ga. Census m. Nancy Cook 12/25/1809 Bulloch Co., Ga, b. 1793. His LWT dated 4/13/1861, probated 8/1862 Bulloch Co., Ga. General Lee "appears" to be a brother of James Lee, Sr., John Lee, David Lee, William Lee, Sr. His issue:

JAMES LEE, SR. "appears" to be a brother of General Lee, Sr., William Lee, Sr., John Lee, David Lee. His LWT dated 9/1840 Bulloch Co., Ga. Named his children and son-in-law, Joshua Kirkland. Wife: Patience.

Bulloch Co. Estates, Book 3A, page 142-146, 12/11/1840, Augustus Lanier signed as having received of James Lee and William Lee, Exrs of Estate of James Lee, Sr., it being part of the property bequeathed to wife, Eliza, by the decd. James Lee, Jr. signed a similar receipt as guardian of Thomas Lee.

Bulloch Co. Estates, Book 3A, page 160-163. March 1843, Annual Return of William Lee, Sr. and James Lee, Jr., Exrs of James Lee, Sr., decd, for 1842. Paid the following legatees: James Lee, Jr., David Lee, William Lee, William Lee as guardian for Thomas Lee, Augustus Lanier, Jesse Bird, Sharp Roberts, Mitchell Lanier, John Lee. Jackson Bird signed for Jesse Bird.

JOHN LEE , appears to be a brother to General Lee, Sr., William Lee, Sr., James Lee, Sr., and David Lee. He was b. Ca 1779 and gave a deed in Bulloch Co. Dated 1799, with his wife, Elizabeth. He died before 1820.

DAVID Lee, appears to be a brother to General Lee, Sr., William Lee, Sr., James Lee, Sr. and John Lee. He was b. Ca 1780. Had deed transactions in Bulloch Co., Ga. 1801-1803. The 1803 deeds some land to General Lee. Bulloch Co. Deed Book AAA, page 325: 1/29/1817, Deed of Gift from David Lee for natural love and affection for his son, Percy Lee...25 head of cattle. David Lee d. Before 1820.

## Wynne

Robert Wynne was the Mayor of ~~Canterbury~~ [www.georgiapioneers.com](http://www.georgiapioneers.com) extends from a family which came to Canterbury during the 1300's. He buried 9/6/1609 at St. George's, Canterbury, England. His wife was buried 9/8/1609, same place. Issue:

I. Thomas Wynne, born 1591, was a grocer, listed as free in 1612. Married 1st, Mary Wickham of Faversham at Orpringo 7/20/1613. On the marriage license was the statement " On 20 July 1629, the wife of Thomas Wynne was buried". He m. 2nd, Ann Nichols on 10/26/1629 at St. Martins. "Thomas Wynne of Canterbury, grocer, widower and Ann Nichols of the Almony of St. Augustine, Canterbury, widow of James Nichols, late deceased, were married at St. Martins on 10/26/1629."

II. Peter Wynne was b. 1605, buried 5/30/1638 at St. George's m. 8/12/1620 at St. Martin's, Martha Coppin of St. Margaret's, Canterbury. Her father, William Coppin, signed their marriage bond. William Coppin was probably a grandson of John Coppin, Member of Parliament from Canterbury from 1553 to 1554. The Coppins are also mentioned in the St. George's Parish Register. William Coppin, gentleman, is buried at St. George's 3/18/1833. His Memorial Table at St. George's.

III. Robert Wynne, Colonel, who migrated to Charles City Co., Virginia. Robert was b. 12-22-1622 at Canterbury, christened at St. Dunstan's Parish. He died in 1675, his LWT being probated in England as well as in Charles City Co., Va. He m. Mary Poythress, the widow of Francis Poythress (She had sons, Peter, Robert and Francis, and Joshua Poythress).
