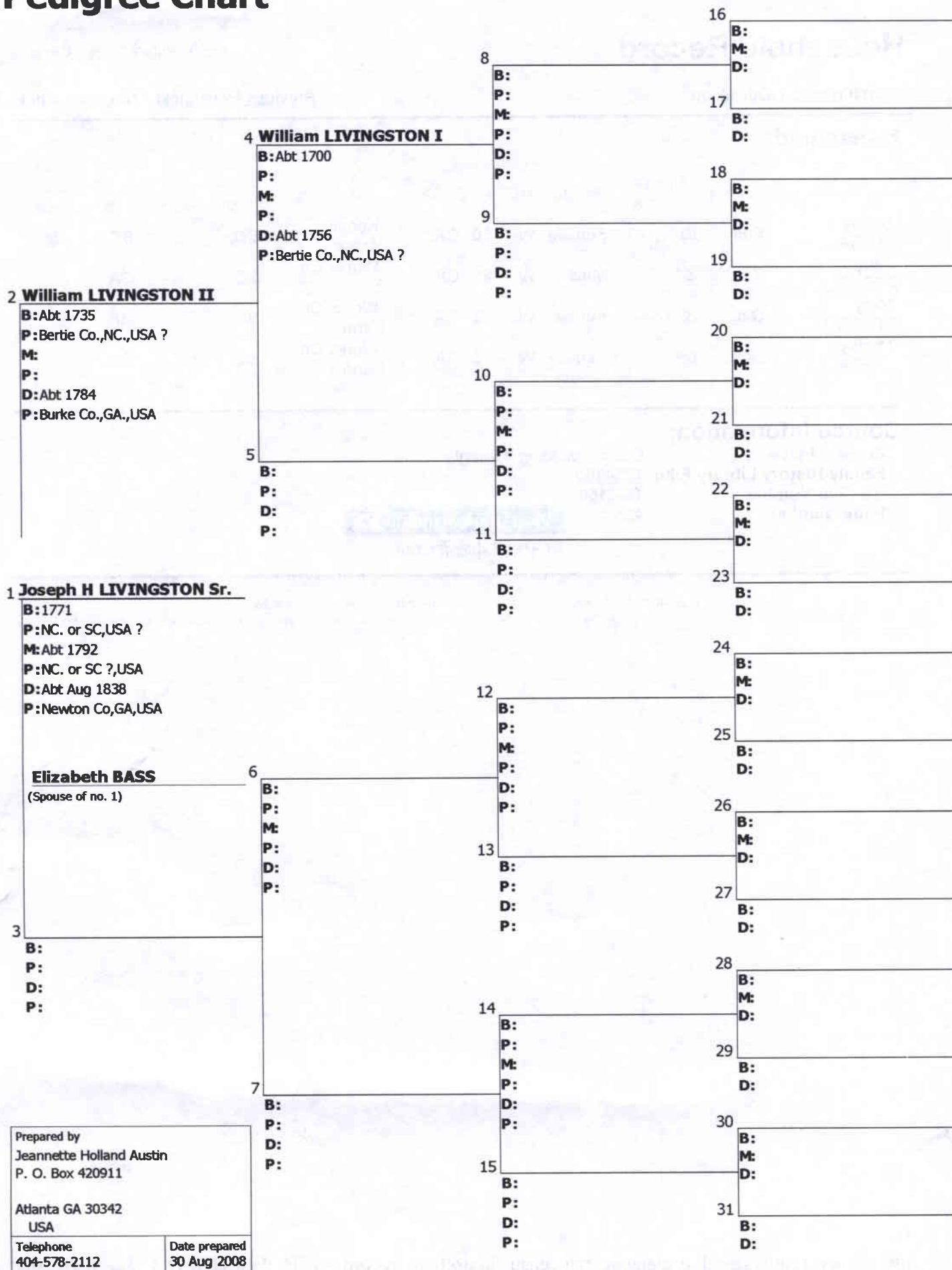


# Pedigree Chart

HI, I sent 2 files. Let me know if you can't open them?

The (1st) file was from Joseph Henry Livi\* b: 1771 forward. He is as far back as we can verify. Some say he came out of SC, others NC. And they show him b: between 1760-1771. but he did die in 1838 Newton Co. GA. He is on your site, along with his son Robt. Bass Livi\*.

The (2nd) file is also from the same Joseph H., I used b: 1760 for him. This goes from him back. This line is shown online and in written publications going back to Scotland. Quite a few of my distant cousins that I have located in AL, and still in GA, believe this, due to a work done in the 1950's by a Gen. Robt. J. Travis. (The Travis Family and its Allies) He is a great grandson of Robt. Bass Livi\*.

Myself and at least 2 other family members believe he got it wrong. Including the authors own grandson a Gordon B. Smith of Atlanta, GA. He is the one that actually said "my grandfather got it all wrong".

So we think there is a Joseph (H?) and he married Elizabeth Bass. Then we all believe then next back is a William. And this is where we think the mis-link to the wrong family line occurred. The #2 file has him married to an Elizabeth Roberts. And born in SC. Gordon strongly believes that he came from NC. and does have some fragmentary info.? So we pick him up in Burke & Jefferson Co. GA. abt 1767.

Since I am the only one that is a Livi\* I have done a DNA test, and it does not match some who say they came from the same line. I do match 3 other Livi\*'s, one traces to Jasmine Co. Ky. abt 1750, and then to MS., he also believes he came from the Livi\*'s of NY and Scotland. And the other to Adams Co., Pa. area also in 1750. There oral history as well as mine also said we came from the famous NY branch. But this is not true.

I've been working on this since 2000, and Gordon since the early 1990's. If you can find anything that would be great.
