will and testament.

property now owned by me to wit

more fully show, by reference to that

thence west along said line two hun  
dred feet to Andrew Pacetty's line,  
thence south along said line forty  
feet to Julius Miller's line, thence  
east along said line two hundred  
feet to wheeler Street. The place of  
beginning with all the buildings loca  
ted on said lot of land.

Second, I will, that after my death,
