again then it is my will that all the

be sold and the proceeds of sale be  
equally divided share and share alike  
between my wife and my children

Twenty five and fifty Dollars.  
he therefore advances to her by me if  
my wife should not marry again then  
at her death the aforesaid property  
is to be sold as also such other property

the proceeds and the balance to my  
children
