

Will of William G. Hunter, Deceased,

Georgia } I, William G. Hunter of said State and County
Brooks County } being of sound and disposing mind, and
memory, but in feeble health, being desirous to settle my
worldly affairs, while I have strength to do so, do make
and publish this my last will and Testament hereby revoking
all former wills by me, at any time heretofore made.

I commit my soul to God, who gave it, and
my body, I desire buried in a decent and Christian
like manner, and my worldly estate I dispose
of as follows.

I desire all my last debts paid, and if it is deemed
advisable and best by my Executors hereinafter
appointed, I desire that they do so, also for the
burial of my wife in the second book, and that title
and farming implements up to the amount of
\$1000 and the balance of the same to be paid in
amount according to the receipt of the same
paid, but I desire that the same be paid in
and should my estate be insufficient to pay the

all personal and mixed be equally divided among my three children in law and the qualifications and conditions may be respected, that if practicable my negroes shall be divided in kind but if not my executors shall be allowed to take the course deemed most to be for the benefit of my heirs, and the proceeds of the sale of my estate may be sold by my executors, either publicly or privately, for the purpose of a division.

I will and desire that the one sixth or a sixth part of the property hereinafter mentioned shall go to my daughter in law Martha Hunter, wife of my son James Hunter, and during the life of my said son, she shall have separate use and, but not alien by gift, sale, lease, or otherwise, from any contract, debt, or liability of my said husband, and I hereby appoint my said son James M. Hunter trustee to manage, use, and control said property for the benefit of my said daughter in law, and my children, and after the death of my said son, the said property shall be divided among my children.

It is my will

Majmuder, wife of Joseph A. Magruder, and her children for her sole and separate use during her life and at her death to be equally divided among her children, the same not to be subject to the contracts, debts or liability of her present or any future husband. Her said husband Joseph A. Magruder is hereby appointed Trustee for my said Daughter to carry out my said intention in regard to her property. The remaining four shares of my property not otherwise disposed of I desire equally divided among my four remaining sons, to go to them absolutely without any limitation.

Whenas full provisions are already made made for my wife Mary Hunter by deed, it is my that will, that my Executors see that the provisions of said deed be carried ^{out} in accordance with her wishes or so as to secure ample provision for her during her life.

I hereby nominate and appoint my son John Miles Hunter and my friend John Henry Hunter my Executors to carry out the provisions of this my last will and Testament and I enjoin on them to see it carried out according to its spirit and intention.

This word divided above I have in the bottom of this third last entered and signed and signing of this will. In witness whereof I have said William G. Hunter, to this my will and to four pages of paper to be going hand set my hand and seal this 21st April 1864.
