

Georgia Cherokee County, Know all men by these presents  
that we George Lathrum John Lathrum  
& J. H. Southwick Securis are held and firmly bound unto  
the Justice of the Inferior Court sitting as a court of  
ordinaries and their Successors in office in the Just and  
full sum of Five Thousand Dollars for the payment of which  
sum well and truly to be made we bind our selves our  
heirs executors administrators of us and each of us  
jointly by these presents Seals with our Seals and dated  
this 23 January 1852.

The substance of the above obligation is such that whereas  
the above bound George Lathrum has this day applied &  
obtained Summary Letters of administration from me John  
C. Hedges Clerk of the Court of Ordinary of the County  
of Cherokee rights & credits of Mary Lathrum deceased.

Now if the above bound George Lathrum shall  
carefully collect and preserve from waste the Goods Chattels  
and effects of the said Mary Lathrum deceased as shall  
appear to be made a true and perfect inventory  
of all such estate and the same being so  
preserved do under say such estate and  
effects with an inventory thereof unto the legal &  
proper administration on or before the first Monday  
in March next or so soon thereafter as the Court  
shall require with all his other actions and  
doings then and faithfully perform the trust  
reposed in him then the above obligation to  
be void else to remain in full force  
in Law.
