tered, converted and disposed of do hereby grant unto  
the said George Youngblood administrator in whose fidelity  
in this behalf I very much confide full power by these  
presents to administer the goods, chattels, rights and  
credits which to him in his lifetime and at the time  
of his death did belong upon special trust and con-  
fidence and for the benefit of himself and of all and  
singular the kindred and creditors of the said intestate  
and to ask, levy, recover and receive the same and to pay  
the debts of an equal nature in which the deceased stood  
obliged in average and proportion so far forth as the goods,  
chattels, rights and credits of the said intestate will extend  
agreeably to the direction of an act of the general Assembly  
of this state heretofore made and provided be the said  
George Youngblood being first sworn according to law to  
make a true and perfect Inventory thereof and to exhibit  
the same into the Register of Probates Office in this County  
in order to be recorded on or before the eighteenth day of  
June now next ensuing and to render a just and true



account calculation and reckoning of the said administration when thereunto required and I ordain, define and constitute you the said George Youngblood administrator in trust as aforesaid of all and singular the goods chattels, rights and credits of the said deceased.
