

John Youngblood & wife Is Ab Youngblood
State of Georgia

Recorded the 4th April 1883

This Indenture made the eight
day of August in this year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and one and in the twenty fifth year of the Independence of the United
States of America Between John Youngblood and his wife Anne
of the State aforesaid and County of Columbia on the one part
and Abraham Youngblood of the State and County aforesaid
of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Youngblood
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to
him in hand well and truly paid by the said Abraham
Youngblood at or before the sealing and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
granted bargained sold released and Confirmed and by these
presents doth grant bargain sell release and Confirm unto
the said Abraham Youngblood his heirs and assigns

all that tract or parcel of land situated in the State and
County aforesaid on the waters of Little Backa adjoining lands
of Benjamin and Jacob Youngblood of Edward Poindexter
Gashy and Messrs. Liebmans including the dwelling house
and part of the plantation wherein the said Abraham
Youngblood ^{man} lives containing one hundred and twenty four
acres the same being part of two surveys originally granted
the said John Youngblood together with all and singular
the rights members and appurtenances thereof whatsoever to the
said tract or parcel of land being belonging or in anywise
appertaining and the remainder reversions rents issues and
profits thereof and of every part thereof to have and to hold
the said tract or parcel of land and all and
singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging
as aforesaid and every part thereof unto the said Abraham
Youngblood his heirs and assigns to the only proper use benefit
and behoof of the said Abraham Youngblood his heirs and
assigns forever and the said John Youngblood and his heirs
the said tract of land and premises aforesaid and every
part thereof unto the said Abraham Youngblood his heirs and
assigns against him the said John Youngblood and his heirs
and all and every other person and persons whosoever shall and
will warrant and for ever defend by their presents and heirs
whereof the said John Youngblood and his wife Anne have
hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first at
me written
