made the fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one in the twenty fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America between John Youngblood and his wife Anne of the State aforesaid and County of Columbia on the one part and Anderson Chesapeake

Originally granted the said John Campbell
together with all and singular his rights,

Together with all our singular in right,
thereof what came to the same tract or parcel of
us were afflicting and the numerous
profits thereof and every part thereof. To have
it parcel of land and all our singular in
is in our hands belonging, as aforesaid and every

Twp. for ever and in Sandwich.
