house-hold and kitchen furniture, plantation tools
forage and provision &c. all that is my own mine in
my own right during her natural life or widow-
hood.

Item 3. If my beloved wife marrye that all my
Estate of all kinds whatever there may be at such
time be equally divided between my beloved wife
Ann and my children to share equally alike and
I hereby authorize my wife Anna Elli to loan to
my other heirs as they come at the age of twenty
one year such property as she may see fit, pro-
vided such loan does not amount to more than
I owed them.

Item 4. I authorize my Executor to make (date
within public or private as they may think best) a
true list of my Estate as they may deem proper for
payment of debts & all other necessary
expenses and then to be valid.

Item 5. I do hereby appoint & make order and ap-
point my beloved wife Anna Elli Executor and
my son Robert M. Elli Executor of this my last
