Butte to be equally divided among them - if however Rachel L. should die without natural heirs her portion shall be the property of Allie C. exclusively - all of this bequeathment is under the following limitation to wit that my husband Dr Robert H. Butte shall have the use of said property during the time of his natural life - We the undersigned agree in the above statement as specifically the last will & testament of Mrs Louisa Butte & that at the making of the same she was in sound mind -

In testimony of the above we have subscribed our names & affixed our seals this fifteenth day of June the same being within six days of the above declaration - June 15th 1862
