I John Eargle of said State and County being of sound mind and disposing memory do make this my last will and testament. I give, bequeath and devise to my daughter Louella Eargle who is afflicted with mental deformities during her natural life, the following property to-wit: Forty acres of land, the same being cut off of, and being part of no. (128) one hundred and twenty eight 2nd. Dist. and 5th. Section of originally Carroll now Douglas County said 40 acres being cut off from the north west side of said lot # 128 and adjoining the lot known as the Mrs. Todd lot and now owned by John Duraw, and South said 40 acres bounded by John Duraw. To have and to hold said parcel of land during her natural life for her support and maintenance in fee simple. After the death of my daughter Louella Eargle then said parcel of land herein before described to revert back to my lawful heirs if I the said John Eargle is not in life.

I hereby constitute and appoint Charley S. McLarty, J. Luther Eargle and D.W. Price to this my last will and testament.
