make and ordain this my last will

I desire and require that he sell all of
the said real Estate, and after paying
all of the expenses of his Executorship

derived from the sale of real Estate or per-
sonal property (after complying with
the above mentioned bequests) be
equally divided among my legitimate
heirs. And I hereby declare and appoint
my beloved Son James N. Abner Crombie

to be my Executor and to all of the foregoing
bequest I recommend his especial estate
And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke
and disannul (all and every other former
testament; wills, legacies, bequest and
Executors, by and in any way before made
Withd and bequested: ratifying and
Confirming this, and no other, to be my
last will and testament.
