Granted Letters Testamentary unto Mess^{rs} Joseph
Davis & Joshua Loper on the Estate of M^{rs} Eliza-
beth Davis, Late of this County Deceased, also
a Warrant of Appraisement, (the 27th Jan^y 1794)

Record of the Last will & Testament, or piece of writing
of John Davis, Deceased, though not Completed
But Advertised for better then 30 Day and no per-
son Complaining therefor established, his will & Testa-
ment & therefore Letters granted, to W^m D. & Jos. Davis.
Now the piece of writing, or will is as follows;

(Viz) In the Name of God Amen

I John Davis Being, as I Expect a Leaving this life
I Recommend my Soul to god, that gave it and my Body to
the Dust, and to ^{this} world; & Concerns I Dispose of as follow^s
(Viz) After my lawfull Debts is paid I Give My True and
Loving wife Elizabeth Davis one Negroe woman Named
Pheoby, and one Negro boy Named Adam, I Give my Sons
Joseph, John, James, William, & Samuel, Ten pounds
each, and George, and Walter, Twenty pounds each
