all the household and kitchen furniture
with one of my horses and one cow - It is
my will that my negro Peter be hired out
until my debts are discharged, I do hereby
Ordain and appoint Thomas May and
Samuel Smith the Executors of my will

and seal this 17th day of March 1813 -
