Lowrey being of sound mind and disposing memory
do make and ordain this my last will and testament
first I resign my body to the dust and commend
my spirit into the hands of God who gave it
I first wish all my Just debts to be paid out of the
present growing crop and if there should be a deficiency
in the crop to discharge all the debts - the balance to
be made out of the Stock property consisting of Horses
Cattle & Hogs, to be paid By my Executors, and I do
appoint my son-in-law Allen Calhoun, son David
McLoughy & my step son P. D. Ward to be my Executors
to carry my Last will & testament in to effect.

I next will to my dear wife Sally Lowrey during her
natural life or under hood the following estates to wit
Sarah. Dittit, Jacob Bedingo. Ligon. Ann. Jackson
Aphron & Sarah Coraline with all there in use
& also the plantations whereon I now live consisting
of one hundred Sixty eight & one half acres as is known
by lot No 102 are hundred & two in the Twelfth dist of
Henry county & also fifty acres of the Lot No 91, more or
less in the same dist & county & to be laid off in the
north part of said lot partly and to be run by a line
running up a spring branch at the back of my house
Lot & Stables running to his line of said lot as well as make
the fifty acres with all the premises there on
And also all the balance of my personal property
household & Kitchen furniture that may remain
after discharging the debts as aforesaid for her benefit
& support. I next will to the lawful heirs of my
son James C. Lowrey & for the benefit of and support
of said James C. Lowrey for life a certain negro
boy by the name Shidman whose proceeds of his
or his labor shall go to the benefit of the said
James C. Lowrey & his family at the discretion of
my said Executors - And also fifty acres of land
being on the East part of lot of land known by no
number and in the 12 dist Henry county & further give
to the heirs of James C. Lowrey as aforesaid and
by the part of all the property that may hereafter
be my wife Sally Lowrey at her death all of
which to be considered in the manner

aforesaid at the discretion of my said Executors and
 in case the said James L. Long should die leaving
 no children then the proceeds to revert to his brothers
 & sisters or their children. I will well to the lawful
 heirs of my son John B. Long in addition to a negro
 boy by the name of Isaac which I gave to him in
 his life time and sixth part of all the property that
 I leave to my wife Polly Long at her death to be
 divided & used by my said Executors for their bene-
 fit. I will to my son David a negro boy
 by the name of Mishaer, and also one hundred
 acres of land being the south west part of lot no 10
 and in the 12 dist of Henry county & also one sixth
 part of all the property that will belong to my wife
 Polly Long at her death. I will to my daughter
 Elizabeth B. Bearell & her children in addition
 to a negro Girl Madison & her in mass that I have pre-
 -viously given her and by the part of all the property
 that I leave to her mother Polly Long or that she
 may have at her death in case she should be the
 longest liver - I will to my daughter Inducta Buff
 & her children in addition to a negro girl named
 Phoebe & her in mass that I have previously given her
 and sixth part of all the property that I leave to my
 wife Polly Long or that she may be possessed of at
 her death provided she should be the longest liver
 I will to my daughter Martha I John son & her in
 mass in addition to a negro girl named Charity & her
 in mass of any thing should be that I have pre-
 -viously given to her one sixth part of all the property
 that I leave to my wife Polly Long or that she
 may be possessed of at her death provided she should
 be the longest liver. In addition to what I have before will-
 ed to my son David, I will that his mother Polly Long give
 him a good father bed & also a new bed & will that she shall give
 my Grand son John B. Long a good father bed. and also I will
 & will that the heirs of my son John B. Long shall have a small
 cult in this premises the of Marion he old but it in the same
