hereby revoking & annulling all other by me heretofore made.
First. I desire & direct that my body be buried in a
decent & christian like manner suitable to my circum-
stances & condition in life. My soul I trust shall re-
turn to rest with God who gave it as I hope for sal-
vation through the merits & atonement of the blessed
Lord & Savior Jesus Christ.
Second. I desire & direct that all my just debts be
paid without delay by my Executors herein after named
& appointed
Thirdly I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Eunice
Ray wife of S. Tucker. H. Ray for her sole & separate
use for & during her natural life free & exempt from
the debts & liabilities of her present or a future hus-
band the following property viz my Negro man Patrick
about twenty three years of age and my Negro
woman Caroline about twenty years of age. The property
in this article contained at the death of my daughter
Eunice. Ray. shall pass to & become the property
of the children and representatives of children of
said Eunice forever.

Fourthly) I give & bequeath to my son Noah. P. See. my two negro boys Ben & Jack, the former about seven years of age & the latter about twelve years of age. To him the said Noah. P. forever.

Fifthly) I give & bequeath to my son David. M. See. the following property viz my negro woman Frank, about forty seven years old & three of her children viz Sam a boy about thirteen years of age Esop a boy of about eight years of age & Jude a girl about six years of age to him the said David. M. forever.

Sixthly) I give & bequeath to the children of my daughter Sarah. Bowen. decd. my negro boy George about five years and hereby desire & direct my Executor herein after named & appointed to sell the said negro boy George & to divide the proceeds of said sale equally among the several children of the said Sarah. Bowen. decd. To the children of the said Sarah forever.

Seventhly) I give & bequeath to Dickson. Bowen. the surviving husband of the late Sarah. Bowen. decd. the sum of Five Dollars to be paid to him by my Executor herein after named & appointed out of any money or moneys, I may have on hand at the time of my death. The reason that I give the said Dickson. Bowen no more than the sum of Five Dollars is, he has, since the death of my daughter Sarah, married another wife & has children by her & I have thought proper in the Sixth article of this my last Will.

& Testament to give & bequeath to the children of my decd. daughter Sarah, the property I should have given her if living, To him the said Dickson forever.

Eighthly) I give & bequeath unto the children of James. L. See. decd. the children of my son William. M. See. decd. & the children of my daughter, Petsy. Ann. Smith wife of Mitchell Smith my negro boy Rueben about fourteen years of age, & hereby desire & direct my Executor herein after named & appointed to sell said boy Rueben & to divide the proceeds of said sale equally among the three above named families of children.

Ninthly) The residue of my property whosoever or whatever it may be, I give & bequeath to my daughter Petsy. Ann. Smith wife of Mitchell. Smith. & hereby desire & direct my Executors herein after named & appointed to sell

said property & to pay over to the said Betsy Ann Smith the nett proceeds of said sale.
(Senthly) I hereby appoint my son Noah. J. See. and my son in Law. Beckner. H. Ray. Executors of this my last Will & Testament.

William. Kimball. William. Blair, & Richard. B. Blair
Executors to this my last Will & Testament. Given
