life or widowhood.

Item. It is my desire that in case of the marriage
or death of my wife Sarah, that there should be
an equal distribution of the whole estate that
she may have in her hands at that time, after
those of them that have had or may hereafter have
given to them sundry in a true account of all that
they have or may hereafter be given to them to wit
Samuel Smith, Rebecca Jones a free person of color
R. Smith Susan Smith, Mary Smith, Abraham Smith
It is my desire that in case of her marriage my wife
Sarah she to have a child's part.

Item. It is my desire that James R. Smith
should have a part of my estate at the discretion
of my executor.
